

Results

Making a difference in the community

- * 66% of the first class of Dreamers graduated from high school when only 34% were expected to graduate, doubling the expected graduation rate. Of the next three classes to complete the program, more than 90% have graduated compared to 60% of their peers.
- * 86% of the Dreamer graduates have gone on to pursue higher education.
- * Boulder Housing Partners reports that crime and vandalism have been reduced by 50% in areas where "I Have a Dream" programs are present.

- * Healthy snacks

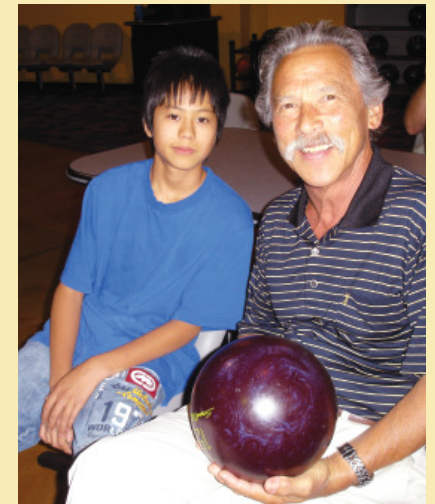
