PEACE COALITION OF NORTHEAST INDIA

PCNI was launched with the objective of convening all stake holders of Peace in the Northeast region to strategize and contribute to Peace and Communal Harmony. PCNI therefore is a network of Individuals, Institutions, Government and Non-governmental agencies who have the concern and willingness to work on the issue. PCNI organizes capacity training in Peace skills (Mediation skills) for mediators, Peace Campaigners, negotiators, Community Leaders and researchers so as to make effective interventions. PCNI facilitates research on Peace issues, and promotes Peace interns to deploy peace activists in vulnerable areas.



ACHIEVEMENTS SINCE 2004

- Organized the North East Regional Youth Summit on Ecology in collaboration with the Chief Wild life Wardens of Nagaland and Arunachal Pradesh in 2004. Some of the outcomes were wild life protection groups, conservation groups and reenforcement of traditional hunting laws, prevention of forest fires and animal rights groups.
- Hosting and Launching the Youth Employment Summit (YES) Campaign Networks in Nagaland (Dec 2004), Mizoram, (Feb 2005) Manipur (July 2005) and Arunachal Pradesh (Sept. 2006). A decade campaign to generate youth employment through multi-stake holder approach.
- Organized the Regional Thematic Workshop "Youth Participation in Agro-Enterprise: Issues and Prospects in September 2007. Some of the outcomes are emergence of farm entrepreneurs, establishment of 2 fruit processing centres, and factory for medicinal and aromatic plants.
- Organized the Regional Consultation on Youth and Employment in 2009. Review of the national Youth Policy is going on through a drafting committee.
- Established Pro Rural Farm and Pro Rural Resource Centre 2008. An animal farm for demonstration and training has been established at Urra Village.
- Organized the Network of "Peace Coalition of Northeast India" PCNI, in 2010. The outcome is the establishment of two state PCNI networks (Manipur and Nagaland) in the first four months of launch.
