ADOPTIONS

Animals are available for adoption from the shelter as well as off-site locations on Saturdays. Our adoption fees, which cover current vaccinations, tests, microchip and spay/neuter for your pet are \$100 for cats and \$175—\$300 for dogs, varying with age, size and breed. We provide support services to ensure animal retention in their new home.

Animal Surrender

If you have a pet that needs rehoming or have rescued a stray dog or cat, we accept new animals on a space available basis and by appointment only. We only decline animals for lack of space, never due to condition, age, health or temperament. We require a surrender fee.

If the shelter is full and you are willing to foster the animal, we will enroll you in our Guest Foster program and post a photo/ bio on our web site. You may also bring the animal to our off-site adoption locations to help find a permanent home.

Sanctuary Program

As a no kill shelter, we provide a permanent home for any animal not adopted and a sanctuary for pets who are not good adoption candidates. This includes older, disabled pets and FELV positivecats.

The sanctuary service is on a space available basis.

Our Mission

Our mission is to make life better for animals by:

- Rescuing and ministering to the indigent animal population of the metroplex;
- Providing shelter, attention and medical care for all of our animals until they find a loving home;
- Providing on-going adoption support services to ensure a lifetime commitment from pet owners;

- Helping reduce animal over-population with low cost spay/neuter referral programs;
- Fostering a respect for all living creatures.



Volunteering
