REACHING MORE FAMILIES WITH FAMILY PLANNING

QUARTERLY REPORT

Here are some great impacts we have made in the past three months:

Family Planning



455 patients went through family planning education and were given access to contraceptives. The number of patients has more than doubled since last quarter!

Antenatal Care

600 women received antenatal care in their village

Deworming Medication



2,110 patients received deworming medication

Immunization



1,900 patients received immunization

In total, Mobile Clinic project reached 5,065 people in the past three months, all for less than 40 cents per person.



Each month, HealthRight continues to support 20 mobile clinics (10 each in Marakwet West and East). Mobile clinics provide growth monitoring for infants, prenatal care for pregnant women, immunizations, deworming medication, first aid, treatments for diarrhea and malaria, and family planning education.

Over the past few months, HealthRight's Mobile Clinics project has been able to reach more people than ever before (seeing 43% more patients since last quarter). There has been a particularly significant increase in the number of families attending family planning education, which is helping more women limit and space their pregnancies through various contraceptive methods. The Mobile Clinics project is working to fill the unmet need for contraception, and improve the quality of life for families in Marakwet.

The work continues but funding is in short supply. Please consider sharing this report and telling your friends and family about our progress.
