WHAT IS A DIAPER BANK?

A nonprofit group that collects, stores and distributes free diapers to homeless shelters, food pantries, family service agencies and faith-based organizations.

- Diaper banks come in many forms and sizes. Some serve a single neighborhood, others an entire region.
- Volunteers staff many diaper bank operations, fundraise on their behalf and raise awareness of diaper need in their communities.

- Diaper banks obtain diapers by purchasing them directly with donated funds, from in-kind donations and through local diaper drives.
