DEVELOPMENT PLAN:

There are four main activities that will be conducted by Second Chance Thoroughbreds Inc. Below please find descriptions of each of these activities.

- 1) **Acquisition** Retired thoroughbred race horses at risk of auction or slaughter shall be acquired by donation or by purchase. In the case of purchases, each horse shall be purchased for \$500.00 or less. This activity shall be conducted by any of the three board members and will be conducted throughout the year as horses become available. The acquisition of horses will take place in New York State at various tracks and privately owned farms where horses are for sale for \$500.00 or less. We expect that this activity will utilize approximately 20% of the not-for-profit corporations overall activities and will be funded 100% by private and public donations.
- 2) **Retraining** Once a retired thoroughbred race horse has been acquired, the horse needs to be retrained. Thoroughbred race horses undergo years of training to be able to race and perform on the race track from the time they are young horses. As such, the retraining process will teach the horse how to become a horse which would be suitable for non-race oriented use by individuals and families interested in adopting an OTTB (off the track thoroughbred). This training will be conducted by the board members and volunteer riders. This will be a daily part of Second Chance Thoroughbreds Inc.'s activities and will be conducted on site at 121 Dawson Hill Road, Spencer, NY 14883. We expect that this activity will utilize approximately 30% of the not-for-profit corporations overall activities and will be funded through donations when adopting a horse from our program.
- 3) **Feeding and Caring** As expected all horses acquired by Second Chance Thoroughbreds Inc. will need to be cared for on a daily basis. This would include feeding, grooming and health related care for each of the horses. We estimate an initial capacity of 5 to 10 horses at any given time. This may increase as we grow. This activity will be conducted by the board members and volunteers. This will be a daily part of Second Chance Thoroughbreds Inc.'s activities and will be conducted on site at 121 Dawson Hill Road, Spencer, NY 14883. We expect that this activity will utilize approximately 40% of the not-for-profit corporations overall activities and will be funded 100% by private and public donations.
- 4) **Community Education and Fundraising** The Summer Fun program which will take place in July and August and is an educational program where adults and children will learn about thoroughbred horses. They will learn to ride, groom and safely handle the horses. This program will always be a full day event and potentially be given several times during the summer months. Arts, crafts and games will take place as well. Our thoroughbreds will attend local open horse shows to demonstrate the versatility of the breed. These events will be conducted throughout the Finger Lakes region of New York during the year. In July, we will be hosting an all thoroughbred event open to the public in Chemung County. These activities will be conducted by the board members and volunteers throughout the year and will be funded through private and public donations. We expect that this activity will utilize approximately 10% of the not-for-profit corporations overall activities.

The above activities serve to further our exempt purpose by preventing thoroughbreds from ending up at auctions containing kill buyers or from being used as research subjects, including terminal research programs and slaughter in general.
