VISIONAR Awards Three More Scholarships!

VISIONAR continues to grow: Thanks to the support of our generous donors and to the continued dedication of Atrapasueños members and volunteers, three new students now enjoy full scholarships to attend college.

Gastón Alberto Madera, María Ángela Contreras, and Maximiliano Alejandro Senno were selected in January 2010 for their academic performance and leadership potential to receive VISIONAR scholarships. They join continuing scholars Emiliano Gudiño (now in his 4th year), Carolina González, Elizabeth Quinteros and Karen Centurión (all three scholars starting their 2nd year of college).

Gastón enrolled in Agronomy studies; María Ángela will pursue Business Administration and Economics, and Maximiliano started a Chemical Engineering program at Universidad Tecnológica Nacional in

San Francisco, Argentina.

Gastón shared with us: "My dream to become an agronomic engineer is now much more achievable (with VISIONAR's help)".

María Angela received the announcement of her scholarship the day before her 18th birthday, and commented, "The VISIONAR scholarship was the best birthday present; it which will allow me to pursue a degree in Business Administration and Economics. I am very happy."

"We see declining enrollment in universities, because many people have to go to work, but getting an education is the best thing we can do

for ourselves," Maximiliano said. "This scholarship is an incentive and a double challenge: to achieve my academic objectives, and to give back to the VISIONAR team that believes in me."

How VISIONAR helps

VISIONAR is a scholarship and mentoring program for outstanding Argentine students who want to pursue a college education (in Argentina).

As long as scholars maintain a GPA of 7/10 and complete 4 hours of community service per month, VISIONAR provides a monthly stipend that covers costs of tuition, books, transportation, clothing, and any other needs related to their college education. The total cost of one full scholarship for one year is USD\$1,400.

In addition, VISIONAR scholars receive mentoring and guidance from an outstanding group of volunteers, led by VISIONAR coordinator Graciela Asis de Lombardi.

VISIONAR ensures our students grow to be successful leaders in their communities.

MEET BOARD MEMBER MARCELO LANZAROTTI

Marcelo, what can you tell us about your background?

I was born and raised in Córdoba city, Argentina. I attended the Catholic University in Córdoba, where I received a degree in Systems Engineering in 2000. Before finishing my thesis, I participated in an exchange program to do research for nine months at Ohio State University in Columbus, OH. While there, I decided that I enjoyed living in the US and that, after finishing my thesis, I would come back to continue my education. I arrived in Chicago in 2002 to pursue a Master of Science in Computer Science at DePaul University. Almost simultaneously I started working for the Information Services division of the University, as part of the Enterprise Systems Administrators team. In addition, recently I completed an MBA in Leadership and Entrepreneurship at DePaul.

What made you join VISIONAR?

Growing up I had the opportunity to attend the college of my choosing and then have my experience in the US as well. Because of these opportunities, I have the career I wanted and do what I really love. I believe that everybody should have the same chances that I had, and by joining VISIONAR I get to help other people that would not otherwise have the means to pursue a university degree. Furthermore, as an Argentine, I want to give back and help the country to prosper and stabilize its economy. I have the firm belief that

education, and therefore, a country's educated population, is the only vehicle to achieve and sustain long-term prosperity and economic independence.

March 2010 - Innovation workshop: inspiring and providing value to VISIONAR supporters

IS NOW: CREATIVITY COMPETENCIES FOR INDIVIDUAL AND CULTURE CHANGE. In this interactive session, Adam taught the skills and mindset that are essential to the creative process, and that can be applied to our professional or personal activities.

In Adam's unique approach, creativity skills were demonstrated through the lens of Argentine cultural traits. For instance, to demonstrate flexibility and adaptation skills, essential to foster creative solutions, Adam invited the audience to practice tango steps, where the male dancer leads and the female dancer typically follows. Adam surprised us by requesting that roles be reversed, with women leading the dance while men followed.
