Introduction

Project “No Excuses” Scholarship Scheme is an initiative of the Ovie Brume Foundation with the overall goal of mitigating the underlying factors that hinder outstanding public primary and secondary school children from having educational opportunities. The scholarship package is designed to cover the following:

- **Healthcare**, which is provided via a reputable healthcare insurance company **annually**;
- **Nutritional** support in form of essential food items provided for beneficiaries and their families **quarterly**;
- **Clothing** which includes two sets of school uniforms and four sets of casual wears **bi-annually**;
- **Educational** resources in form of books and stationary items as required **termly**; and
- **Transportation** to and fro school to support beneficiaries’ continuous stay in school **termly**.

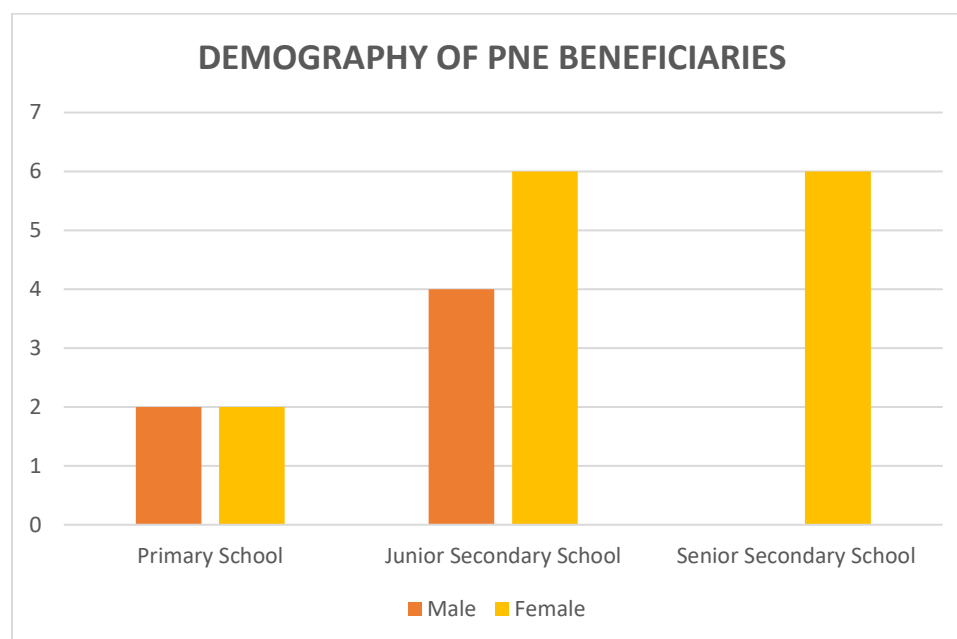
Expected Outcomes of Project “No Excuses” Scholarship Scheme

The expected outcomes from “Project No Excuses” are outline below:

- Improved access to education;
- Improved ability to learn;
- Increased access to standard health services;
- Improved nutritional status;
- Completion of primary and secondary school education.

Socio-demographic Description of beneficiaries

19 (M6: F13) beneficiaries are currently enrolled on the PNE scholarship scheme and their demography is represented in the graph below. For the female beneficiaries, there are 6 in Senior Secondary School, 5 in Junior Secondary School and 2 in Primary School. For the male beneficiaries, there are 2 in Primary School and 4 in Junior Secondary School. The ages of beneficiaries in primary school range from 7 – 12 years while the ages of beneficiaries in secondary school range from 12 – 18years.



Quarter One 2019 Progress Report

First quarter of 2019 marked the commencement of the second academic term and the inclusion of a new beneficiary to the project. Beneficiaries resumed back to school in the second week of January and all their needs under the scholarship scheme have been provided. All support regarding their education and academic improvement have been provided; nutritional support, clothing support healthcare support under the health insurance scheme have been provided for all beneficiaries. In addition, beneficiaries with transportation challenges and requiring support, have received support. They no longer get to school late, they have been able to meet up with their school activities and their grades have improved.

Within the period under review, all beneficiaries participated in activities organized at the Foundation. Beneficiaries in Secondary School participated in Drama, Taekwondo, Dance, ICT and Art; they also participated in the 2nd edition of Oracle Academy Students Hackathon competition, with the objective of accessing their technological competence. Also, beneficiaries in the senior secondary class are beneficiaries of a funded project, "Empowerment Corner", a "Safe Spaces" initiative of the Ovie Brume Foundation Youth Centre, which is a holistic intervention that integrates life skills, sexual reproductive health, entrepreneurial skills, leadership, and mentoring.

Beneficiaries in primary school continued with the "After School" classes, they are members of the Foundation's "Book Club" alongside other pupils who are currently not benefitting from the PNE scheme. The "Book Club" has improved the vocabulary, spelling and pronunciation of members as well as their reading culture.

All beneficiaries have tremendously improved in their academics and social skills.

Limitations





Some of the limitations are still pending.





- a. PNE beneficiaries are still having accommodation challenges due to recent urban development activities within the state and this has resulted into relocation by some of the beneficiaries.
- b. Delay in issuing end of term result by the school authorities, affect the individual reporting and assessment of the beneficiaries.
- c. There is an increasing number of underserved but deserving children who are currently not benefiting from the PNE.





Recommendation

- a. Provision of adequate resources to provide the necessary services required by the current.
