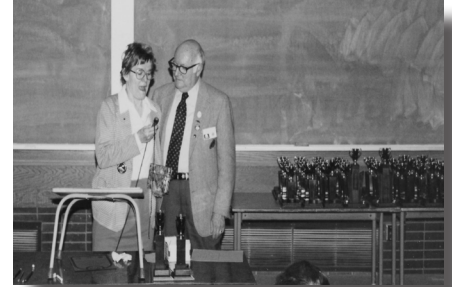

COACHES: IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO REVIEW CAREFULLY WITH YOUR TEAM MEMBERS

Photos & Videos: Photos and videos will be taken throughout the conference. By attending International Conference, you are granting FPSPI permission to use your image in FPSPI promotional and program materials.

Friendships & Fun: The competition is very important, but not as important as making friends and experiencing the opportunities available at IC 2016. You have a unique opportunity to meet and make friends with people from all over the world. One requirement of this conference is that everyone has fun!

Conduct: As guests of Future Problem Solving Program International and Michigan State University, participants are expected to conduct themselves maturely and appropriately.

Use of alcohol and/or illegal drugs, smoking, destructive behavior to either persons or property, or actions that might endanger others will not be tolerated. *Individuals violating this code will be asked to leave immediately and will be assessed for any damages.* No reimbursement of fees will be provided to participant(s) asked to leave.

Coaches & Chaperones: Coaches and chaperones are responsible for the behavior and well-being of their students. *Please know where your students are at all times.* During the problem solving competition, coaches and chaperones are not to be in the area of competition. Monitors have been instructed to ask unauthorized persons to leave and will report the names of those who do not comply. Please do not jeopardize your team by refusing to cooperate. Chaperones are responsible for appropriate behavior at Saturday night dances.

Quiet Hours: Out of respect for others, please observe "quiet hours" in the sleeping areas between 11:00 PM and 6:30 AM. The residence hall lounges are available for late socializing, but the sleep of others should be considered. *Chaperones are asked to enforce quiet hours.*

FPSPI Staff/Emergency Contact: Messages for members of the FPSPI staff or emergencies relating to IC can be left at Problem Solving Central or by calling FPSPI phone 321-720-4747. Other emergencies, call 911.

Security: Do NOT leave doors unlocked in the residence halls. FPSPI cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items.

Problem Solving Central (PSC): For general information go to Wilson Hall West Lounge, throughout the conference as scheduled.

Messages: Messages for participants will be posted on the bulletin board at the residence halls.

Meals: Entrance to the assigned Michigan State University dining halls for meals is permitted by the wristband and access card provided. Meals are available only during the published dining hours.

This may be the first time that many students use a college dining hall, so please show courtesy - remove your food stuff from the table and socialize in the beautiful outdoors when finished eating. Shoes and shirts are required in the dining hall.

Neck Wallets: The FPSPI neck wallets serve as your passes to all conference events. Persons not wearing them may not be admitted or may be asked to make the \$5 donation required of guests for entrance. An "observer" who has not pre-registered may donate \$5 at the door of each event. Seating at the Munn Ice Arena is reserved for registered participants and those not registered may be asked to wait to be seated.

Zippy Mart: The Zippy Mart is located in Wilson Hall C1. It will be open for business as scheduled in the program. (HMI will be situated in the Wilson Hall West Lounge area, Premier Photos will be in Wilson Hall C3.)

Tours: If you reserved space on an optional side trip, please be at the designated Wilson Hall West Loop at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled departure time. Departure times will be posted at the HMI travel desk. Tour busses cannot be delayed for late arrivals, and no refunds will be made if you miss the bus.

Distribution of Competition Packets: Score sheets for all competitions will be available on line in ROCS after the conclusion of the Award Ceremony. Complete results for all competitions will be posted online no later than June 13.

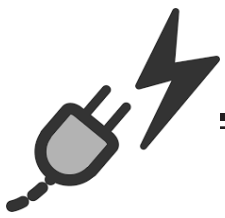
Checking Out: A coach/chaperone must collect keys for all of the group's rooms and take them to the resident hall reception desk to check out. Curious, patient, pragmatic, passionate, leader, Alec founded Bractlet to increase the efficiency of the built environment and leads the team as CEO. He is able to understand the multi-disciplinary technical solutions Bractlet brings under one roof along with business strategy and management.

Alec is listed on Forbes 30 under 30 in energy and graduated from Georgia Tech in Mechanical Engineering with highest honors. He designed, developed, and oversaw the launch of Bractlet's hardware, software, and analytical products that on average reduce building energy consumption by 30%+. In addition, Alec raised over \$2mm in funding for Bractlet.

Alec loves travelling and is fortunate to have travelled to over 20 countries and 5 continents throughout South East Asia, South America, Europe, and Africa. He loves to play golf, ping pong, and baseball.

As a Global Issues Problem Solver and Grand Champion for Community Problem Solving since he was in 6th grade, Alec Manfre epitomizes the Future Problem Solving mission. 2016 FPSPI "Creating the Future" Scholarship Recipients

Cole Cunningham **Danville High School, Danville, Illinois**



The 2016 *Creating the Future Scholarship* winner is Cole Cunningham a student at Danville High School, Danville, Illinois. A participant since sixth grade, Cole has participated on Community Problem Solving Teams to address Shaken Baby Syndrome, pill disposal, bullying, veteran assimilation into the community, and the stigma of mental illness. Several of these teams incorporated the collaboration with students from Australia. Cole writes, "I participated in FPS in middle school and was infatuated with the program because of its life lessons and opportunities that it provided. Educational Disparities

Education is considered to be the pathway to an informed, future-focused population. In many countries, education is publically funded by the central government or by state governments, with options for privately funded schools. In some countries, school funding/regulation is largely local and tied to property taxes. Other countries struggle to fund education at all. In addition to differences in funding, other economic and social factors contribute to educational disparities: family earnings, health status, gender, political participation, and social class.

It's All in the Genes

The genes of organisms can be altered using biotechnology techniques. New genes can be inserted into plants and animals to create new varieties and breeds or to lessen certain genetic activity such as susceptibility to disease. Since 1970 GM has helped produce greater numbers of crops with higher nutritional value and has been prominent in animal agriculture. Critics claim there are serious ethical, ecological, and economic issues with GM techniques. For example, GM crops can cross-pollinate with non-GM crops creating unpredictable characteristics in plants. Bioherbicides and bioinsecticides can be added to crop seeds, but are not always effective. Resistant weeds now infest 75 million acres of land across the world. Domesticated animals are being genetically modified to produce proteins that have applications for human medicine – proteins to control blood clotting or kill cancer cells, for example.

3D Printing

3D printing is an emerging technology that was first used in arts and hobbies. Because of its widespread applications, 3D printing is now being used in business, medicine, and industry. In biochemistry, engineers create 3D printed body parts. NASA has a 3D printer on the International Space Station. The European Space Agency (ESA) is looking into the feasibility of building a base on the moon using 3D printing. 3D printers are already inexpensive enough to use at home and universal enough for schools to include them as part of their technology or “maker” programs. The technology continues to develop at a fast pace and many breakthroughs are on the horizon. Experts predict there will be improvements to printing speed and quality and that 3D printed food and 3D bioprinting will soon be the norm.

Identity Theft

Identity theft is a form of stealing someone’s identity. Most often, identity thieves steal personal financial information, buy things for their own gain, and pay for none of it. Frequently, identity thieves gain access to personal information through business and government databases that are not secure. Dates of birth, full names, bank account details and identification numbers are part of the information sought by identity thieves. Stolen identities can be used to fund other crimes such as illegal immigration, terrorism, or drug crimes. It can be extremely difficult to find and prosecute identity thieves as they are often from different countries than the individuals whose identities they are stealing and they obtain personal details online.
