

Gracious Paradise Charitable Foundation (GPCF), a registered not for profit organization, was established in 2001 to enable the vulnerable and weaker sections of the society, with a special focus on children in difficult circumstances, towards empowerment and dignified human life. Headquartered in Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh, the organization's present thrust area is on the and development of children. It aims to create awareness among the children on various personal and social issues that affect them, enable the children to access better health care and services and promote child rights especially of survival, development and participation.

GPCF works in a number of slum communities and selected pockets in the Hyderabad city and Nalgonda district. The organization implements various programs on health, hygiene, education, values, human rights, and also works in active collaboration with School administration and Village Administration. Some of the major activities carried out by the organization are:

- 1) Home away from Home (HaH) for children on the street which provides basic facilities and mainstreams them through constant care, acceptance and special supportive environment.
- 2) Non formal education and capacity building of children slum locality.
- 3) Formation of child clubs to empower the children
- 4) Observing key developmental day's – along with the children
- 5) Celebrating major festivals irrespective of religions to enhance the communal harmony

2) Note on precise activities undertaken with evidence with reference to the objects specified in Trust deed/ MOA and others giving details there of like concrete details with date, venue, addresses of activities and names and addresses of beneficiaries:

Gracious Paradise Charitable Foundation (GPCF) always believes in providing equal opportunities to the people from all walks of life. In this pursuit initiated various child developmental activities to empower and enhance the self esteem of the children. The major activities carried out by the organization in this regard and in line with the objectives mentioned in the MOA of GPCF are:

Major Activities

During the formation and after the formation, GPCF, School administration focused on many activities to ensure that the set objective is achieved, enlisted below are major activities taken up in this intervention, in each of these major activities, they were many more sub activities:

- **Formation of Child Clubs** - To improve the life style and to protect the rights of the children through formation of village level child clubs
- **Building Holistic awareness on Child Clubs** - To child club members are engaged themselves to initiate the process of setting up systems and to bring the club into a complete shape, formation of committee and defining their roles and responsibilities
- **Focusing on 'Child Rights'** - To educate the child clubs about the 20th November 1989 UN resolution on child life, protection and 58 child rights
- **Developing 'Leadership Skills'** - To identify the leadership skills and improve the same
- **Intending to improve 'Quality of LIFE'** - To explain about the physical and mental adversities one faces during the life time and to equip the child for holistic development
- **Reporting and Documentation** - To provide skills and knowledge on reporting and documentation
- **Chinnari Vidayam (First Aid)** - To improve the service motto among the children, to impart basic information on medicine and to equip them how to administer first aid
- **Bala Nidhi (Savings)** - To imbibe the concept of saving and to impart knowledge and skill on how to mobilize resources for their club
- **Kala Jatha (Folk and Dance)** - Training programme on 'Kala Jatha' (Folk and Dance)
- **Balala Mela (Children Festival)** - Balala Mela (Children Festival)
- **Child Consultation** - To self appraise about the progress made by child club
- **Developing Eco Clubs** - To form a subcommittee within the club titled eco club, to imbibe the importance of environment safety and to ensure that all the members of the club plan take steps towards green revolution

DETAILS OF ACTIVITIES CARRIED ON BY THE TRUST AND THEIR RELEVANCE TO THE MAIN OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

The trust is running an orphanage for the last 9 years, at S1/B-352, Sachivalaya Nagar, Vanasthalipuram, wherein at present, 65 children belonging to the poor and needy sections of the society are being provided shelter, food and education. We arrange campaigns in the slum areas and the orphaned and needy children are identified at these campaigns and are shifted to the orphanage and the entire needs of the children like food, shelter and education are taken care of by the trust. Children who does not have any basic education are being provided free education at our campus where, teachers and trainers impart basic education so that they can attend regular school for pursuing higher studies. The children after attaining a certain level are being sent to Government School, Sahebnagar, Hyderabad. The aim of the trust is to provide basic education to the orphaned children in order to make them responsible citizens of the country and also make them lead a decent life. Some of the children who have been trained in our orphanage are pursuing engineering and MBA courses.


Further, the trust is actively pursuing the program of promoting child clubs, wherein children studying in Government schools of Hayatanagar and Saroornagar Mandals of Ranga Reddy District, and Pochampally Mandal of Nalgonda District are brought together and for each group programs on various fields like child protection, child rights, development of life skills and study skills, are conducted and various sub committees are formed for education, health, green and clean, information and communications. Further, the trust conducts, games and sports to provide them overall development. The trust is providing note books and text books to the poor and needy students studying in the Government schools.

The trust is also providing nutritional food, clothes and conducting health camps to take care of their health needs, of the old and aged people of the society. These programs are carried out continuously, on an ongoing basis.

The trust is also conducting various programs for women and the youth on Skill training, and awareness programs on various government schemes which can be useful for them to take up projects for self employment.

All the above programs are carried out in pursuance of the main objects of the trust which provide for

- a) To provide relief and rehabilitation measures for destitute, orphans, old age people, physically challenged and the poor and needy sections of the society.
- b) To promote activities for promoting welfare programmes for the poor people in the society across different areas in the form of free food, clothes, grains and other accessories that are needed for them.
- c) To establish, promote, set-up, maintain, assist, finance, support and aid to help in setting up and maintaining and running orphanages, homes; or other establishments for relief and help to the poor, old, physically challenged and destitute.
- d) To provide education for the poor and needy children by giving them financial assistance, food and tuition fees and to establish and run child clubs intended to provide them life skill education, leadership training, child rights, self protection and provide them to participate in multifarious activities.
