


REPORTING ON 2017:

154 children received individual assistance in the amount of **7 478 695,33 UAH.**

4 222 428,95 UAH

96 children received individual assistance in the form of medicines and medical supplies

450 000,00 UAH

38 patients in Kyiv and Lviv received the drug Cosmegen.

This is an antitumor medicine that is not registered in Ukraine, therefore, it is not purchased by the state and is not sold in pharmacies. Zaporuka imports these drugs legally obtaining a one-time permission from the Ministry of Health.

26 000.00 EUR were given to Nastia Berestenko to continue her rehabilitation after a transplantation.

Karolina Lashchenko had brachyterapy and operation at the Gustave Roussy Clinic in France, the cost of treatment was 27 573 EUR.


Liliia Shcherbak started MIBG therapy the cost of which was 7 598.00 EUR.

Also we partially paid for Zhenia Zechu's MIBG therapy and autotransplantation (22 980.00 EUR) at the Clinic in Bergamo, Italy.

It is not performed in Ukraine because of the lack of the necessary iodine isotope. All the children were provided with plane tickets thanks to the corporate social responsibility program of the Ukrainian National Airlines "Pid Krylom" ("Under the Wing").





71 children lived at the Center Dacha, most of them were with both parents. Also 38 family members had an opportunity to live free of charge at the Center when the child was in the hospital.



During the year our physiotherapists helped **35 child cancer patients** to undergo rehabilitation after surgery, holding **830 sessions** with them.



We purchased equipment for intensive care: monitors of vital functions, aspirators, tonometers and others in the amount of **243 103.41 UAH.**



69 children cancer survivors participated in the spring and summer Winner' Camps. **One family** visited the event for children survivors in Turkey and **four children** received rehabilitation in Germany.



The reanimation department in the pediatric department of the Institute of Neurosurgery and 8 patients' rooms in the hematological department of the Lviv Pediatric Hospital were renovated. The last year expenses amounted to 713 998.15 UAH.



159 pediatricians took part in lectures and seminars on the topic of timely diagnosis of cancer in children.



During the year, we supported the departments where we operate with medical supplies that are not provided by the state. The expenses made up 127 720.68 UAH.

In the first part of the year Zaporuka Foundation **99 980.00 UAH** supported financially the nurses of the pediatric department of the National Cancer Institute. Unfortunately, we haven't found funding to continue implementing this project but we are working on it.



The team of our psychologists held 289 consultations for children and 323 consultations for their family members. We published the book for teenagers "When You Are Ill" written by the head of our psychological service Natalia Zabolotna.



Information Center for Migration helped **151 former migrant** workers to receive pensions earned in Italy in the amount of **291 856.00 EUR.**



We started cooperation with the architecture company AIMM that works on a construction project of the new Center Dacha for 15 families.



Besides, this year with our international partner, Soleterre Foundation, we elaborated and implemented a new system of monitoring and evaluation of our activities.



Together with Oleksandra Baklanova we elaborated a strategy of the Foundation development for the next five years. Also Gres & Todorchuk PR agency elaborated a communication strategy for the Foundation and helped us to implement it.

In December 15 children cancer survivors took part in the photo session by Dmytro Perekrutov, one of the most famous photographers of Ukraine who worked with such well-known celebrities as Vincent Cassel, Paco Rabanne and many other Ukrainian stars.

Zaporuka plans only to get better and begin construction our own building for the Dacha Center which will be able to receive all those who need help.
