Orion Communities has recently completed our STARS* pilot program during the fall semester with the Phoenixville Area High School. As you know, a donor gifted Orion 100 laptops from TeamChildren with software including BrillKids and web-filtering software. The donor's requirement was for Orion to create a program to give the computers to children from low income households that included teaching digital literacy to their parents and that there be a strong reading component.

By all accounts our STARS* pilot has been a success! The reaction of the parents and children has been very enthusiastic. The school district has also been encouraged by the results of the pilot and have recently sent out notices to additional families to join STARS*. Our next step is to prepare for full implementation in March/April of this year. Many thanks to the TeamChildren staff and BrillKids for helping to make computer access and education enrichment programs via computer a reality for our most vulnerable children and their families.
