Getting another laptop would mean the world to me as it would help me get my school work done and let me have free time playing games and watch videos. I hope this letter will allow you to understand the problems I have to go through everyday ever since 2013. I am extremely grateful that you will help me get a laptop for I simply cannot afford one.
