Women Empowerment



Recognizing that true empowerment is key to enabling women to assert their presence in a predominantly male-dominated society and take on leadership roles, RSKS India has actively undertaken various projects for women's empowerment this year. The organization has successfully implemented the following initiatives:

STOP VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN

Violence against women (VAW) stands as a deplorable violation of human rights, and addressing this issue is of utmost importance. RSKS India is actively engaged in a range of awareness activities and programs, including workshops, puppet shows, camel cart shows, road rallies, posters making, and story-telling, all aimed at creating awareness and fostering a society free from violence. In the current year, as part of the HER VOICE campaign to Stop Violence Against Women, RSKS India conducted the following activities:

ACTIVITIES

- Conducted a total of 98 monthly group meetings, forming 18 village adolescent children groups facilitated by RSKS India. Approximately 500 rural adolescent children were educated about social issues, fostering collective action against prevalent challenges.



- Executed a Mass Awareness Campaign on Counter Gender-Based Violence with School Students, engaging **2400 students from 48 schools** through road rallies, poster competitions, storytelling, and other activities.
- Organized a Mass Awareness Campaign on Counter Gender-Based Violence, reaching **402 slum dwellers, nomadic, and rural community members** across 12 different locations.
- Implemented various awareness activities at the International Pushkar Fair 2022, including puppet shows, camel cart awareness, peer-to-peer awareness, and my selfie awareness, enlightening **thousands of attendees** about different social issues.
- Executed a Life Skills Education Programme for approximately **500 rural community members** in 15 different villages.
- Conducted Mass Awareness Workshops on END Domestic Violence & Legal Rights, engaging around **550 rural individuals in 15 different villages**.
- Organized a Poster Competition on End Child Marriage at **41 schools, involving 2051 school children**. Participants were provided with essential art supplies, and winners received water bottles, sketch drawing books, and geometry boxes.
- Facilitated a One-Day Informative Training with Adolescent Groups (School Students) on Stop Eve Teasing & Raise Voice With Leadership, incorporating flipcharts, debates, and group discussions. Over **443 school students from 16 different schools** participated.
- Promoted sports among girls by distributing 12 pairs of PT shoes and 14 sports dresses to **26 school girls** from two different schools.

IMPACTS

- **Empowered Adolescent Groups:** 98 monthly meetings led to the formation of 18 adolescent children groups, empowering around 500 rural youths with information on social issues. They collectively took a stand against these challenges.
- **Informed School Children:** A Mass Awareness Campaign on Counter Gender-Based Violence reached 2400 school children from 48 schools. Information was disseminated through road rallies, poster competitions, and storytelling sessions.
- **Community Awareness:** A Mass Awareness Campaign on Counter Gender-Based Violence extended its reach to 402 slum dwellers, nomadic, and rural community members across 12 locations, fostering awareness and community action.



- **Social Awareness at Pushkar Fair:** Various activities at the International Pushkar Fair enlightened thousands about different social issues, utilizing platforms like puppet shows, camel cart awareness, peer-to-peer engagement, and my selfie awareness.
- **Life Skills Empowerment:** Life Skills Education Programs positively impacted around 500 rural community members from 15 different villages, enhancing their life skills and knowledge.
- **Combating Domestic Violence:** Mass Awareness Workshops on END Domestic Violence & Legal Rights engaged approximately 550 rural individuals in 15 villages, contributing to a greater understanding of legal rights and domestic violence issues.
- **Child Marriage Awareness:** The Poster Competition on End Child Marriage involved 2051 school children across 41 schools, distributing essential art supplies and recognition items to participants. This initiative raised awareness and discouraged child marriage.

- **Adolescent Empowerment Against Eve Teasing:** A One-Day Informative Training with Adolescent Groups in 16 different schools engaged more than 443 students, equipping them with knowledge and skills to combat eve-teasing and encouraging leadership.
- **Promoting Girls' Sports:** Encouraging sports among girls, the distribution of 12 pairs of PT shoes and 14 sports dresses to 26 school girls from two different schools aimed to promote physical activity and gender equality.

WOMEN SELF HELP GROUPS



Collaboration is a potent force for positive change, as the adage goes, "Alone we can do so little; together we can do so much." RSKS India has established **30 Self Help Groups** comprising approximately **300 women**. These groups have been facilitated with a total of **INR 1,82,05,360** in low-interest loans, empowering women to initiate their self-employment ventures and collectively address challenges within their communities.

Currently, over **100 women's self-help groups** under the auspices of RSKS India are active, mobilizing around **1100 rural women**. These groups not only provide livelihood support but also impart essential knowledge about banking activities, fostering financial literacy.



Empowered by micro-loans from RSKS India, these self-help group women have embarked on various self-employment ventures in both the farming sector (such as Azolla farming, kitchen gardens, vermicompost, etc.) and non-farming sector (including cattle husbandry, fish husbandry, vegetable shops, etc.). This initiative marks a significant stride towards economic independence and community development.

IMPACTS

- All members are successfully engaged in their respective self-employment ventures or businesses.
- Serving as role models, these women have played a key role in reshaping the conservative mindset prevalent in the rural community.
- Women from rural areas are making significant contributions to both farming and non-farming sectors.
- Members of the SHG groups have attained self-reliance and independence.
- These women actively participate in family decision-making processes.
- Achieving economic stability, they now contribute financially to their families.
- An impressive 90% of these women regularly visit the SHG bank each month.
- Every single woman in these groups is well-versed in various banking activities.
- They have fostered a strong sense of mutual care and support within the community.



CAPACITY BUILDING, LIFE SKILLS AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Empowering rural women through capacity building, life skills, and leadership training is essential for enhancing their confidence, communication, and cognitive abilities. RSKS India recently organized a Two-Day Capacity Building & Life Skills Education Training for **260 members** across **25 different rural villages** within self-help groups. During this training, participants engaged in a variety of games, tasks, activities, and lessons to grasp the principles of capacity building, life skills, and leadership.

The program aimed to instill self-awareness among these women, highlighting how they can actively contribute as leaders to bring about positive change in society. Through the training, the participants not only expanded their knowledge and skills but also witnessed a remarkable boost in their confidence levels. Now equipped with enhanced abilities, the women from these self-help groups can articulate their ideas confidently, even within their families. This newfound empowerment enables them to manage their employment ventures effectively, thereby increasing their overall livelihood resources.



IMPACTS

- Participants experienced a significant boost in their confidence levels, allowing them to express themselves more confidently in various aspects of their lives.
- The training contributed to enhancing verbal communication skills among the women, enabling them to articulate their ideas effectively.
- The program fostered cognitive empowerment by providing participants with valuable knowledge and skills, thereby expanding their intellectual capabilities.
- Emphasis on leadership training empowered the women to recognize their potential as leaders, instilling a sense of responsibility and the ability to bring positive change to their communities.
- The training aimed at instilling self-awareness, encouraging participants to actively contribute to societal development by leveraging their leadership skills.



- As a result of the program, the trained women are better equipped to play leadership roles, contributing positively to the social and economic development of their communities.
- Participants can now confidently express their ideas within their families, fostering a more inclusive and supportive family dynamic.
- The acquired skills enable women from self-help groups to manage their employment ventures more effectively, leading to increased livelihood resources.
- Empowered women serve as role models within their communities, inspiring others and challenging traditional gender norms.
- The program's holistic approach has not only improved individual capacities but has also created a ripple effect, positively influencing the entire community.



EDUCATION

"Education wields the transformative power to reshape the entire world." In the context of India's patriarchal society, empowering the girl child through education is as vital as medicine for a patient. Education stands as a cornerstone for the construction of a well-developed society. Recognizing the paramount significance of education, RSKS India has undertaken various programs throughout the year, embodying their commitment to illuminating minds and fostering societal progress. These educational programs were as follows:

PATHSHALA: A VALUE BASED EDUCATION SCHOOL

Pathshala Schools, an impactful initiative by RSKS India, have illuminated the paths of more than 220 marginalized adolescent girls, aged 10-19, in 5 remote rural areas. Through the transformative power of education, this project became the catalyst for empowerment for girls at various stages, be it school dropouts, current students, or those entirely illiterate. In addition to academic lessons, the curriculum encompassed crucial aspects of personal development, covering topics like 'good touch-bad touch,' sexual and reproductive health, science models, environmental conservation, anti-plastic initiatives, and the advocacy against child marriage.



The educational journey extended to include life skill training, leadership development, capacity building, sports, discipline, and the instillation of moral values. Moreover, the program went beyond the confines of the classroom, celebrating numerous social days and festivals with the girl children.



Monthly Parent-Teacher Meetings served as a platform for parents to comprehend their child's progress. The holistic support from RSKS India extended to providing school uniforms, shoes, and all necessary educational materials. In reflecting on the project's impact, we can affirm that it has not only educated but empowered these adolescent girls, sculpting them into well-rounded individuals ready to integrate seamlessly into the mainstream of education. In the contemporary landscape, where value-based education is paramount, this initiative stands as a beacon, equipping these girls to thrive in a competitive world.



IMPACTS



- The Pathshala Schools has positively impacted over 220 marginalized adolescent girls aged 10-19 in 5 remote rural areas.
- The transformative power of education has served as a catalyst for empowerment, addressing the needs of school dropouts, current students, and entirely illiterate girls.
- This project taught these girls about 'good touch-bad touch,' sexual and reproductive health, science models, environmental conservation, anti-plastic initiatives, and advocacy against child marriage.
- These girl learned essential life skill training, leadership development, sewing training, capacity building, sports, discipline, and the instillation of moral values, ensuring a well-rounded approach to the girls' development.

- Celebration of social days and festivals with the girl children.
- Monthly Parent-Teacher Meetings provide a platform for parents to understand and actively engage in their child's progress.
- More than 220 rural girls got Pathshala school uniforms, shoes, and all necessary educational materials, removing barriers to education.
- The project shaped these girl into well-rounded individuals prepared to seamlessly integrate into the mainstream of education.
- This Project Equipped the girls to thrive in a competitive world.



EDUCATION FOR EVERY GIRLS

Girls' education in Rajasthan faces challenges, with many girls being illiterate or dropping out due to financial constraints, exacerbated by the impact of the Covid-19. RSKS India's 'Education For Every Girl' initiative addresses this issue, supporting **2061 girls** from **125 different rural locations** this year.

These girls, hailing from families engaged in various occupations such as farming, daily wage labor, masonry, truck driving, and marginalized communities, were identified through a baseline survey conducted by school authorities, village officials, and RSKS Team members. RSKS India intervened by providing essential educational items (school bags, notebooks, plain drawing book, sketch drawing book, geometry boxes, stationery kits etc), hygiene essentials (handkerchiefs, soaps, sanitary napkins etc), food packets, school fees, uniforms, water bottles, and sweaters.

Beyond material support, the initiative included education on social issues, emphasizing the importance of education, and covering topics such as moral values, discipline, and nutrition. This project met a year's educational and hygiene needs for these girls, concurrently fostering support and encouragement for girl child education within their families post the challenges posed by the recent health crisis.



EMPOWERING EDUCATION: SUPPORT FOR NEEDY SCHOOL BOYS



Identifying bright boys in various rural areas facing financial constraints, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan discovered that their families struggled to afford school fees. In response, RSKS India conducted a program, distributing school fees and educational materials to alleviate the immediate needs of three deserving school boys.



IMPACTS

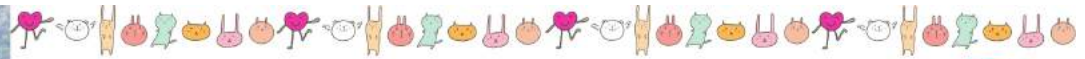
- RSKS India's 'Education For Every Girl' initiative targeted the critical issue of girls' education and supported 2061 School girls.
- Supporting 2061 girls across 125 locations, the project provided essential educational materials, hygiene kits, food packets, and financial assistance for school fees, uniforms, and more.
- Focused on rural farmers, daily wage laborers, masons, truck drivers, and marginalized communities, the initiative identified and supported girls from diverse backgrounds.



- Beyond material support, the initiative imparted knowledge on social issues, emphasizes the importance of education, and covers topics such as moral values, discipline, and nutrition.
- The project not only met a year's educational and hygiene needs but also encouraged continued support for girl child education within families.
- More than 90% of these girls got excellent marks in their exams.

IMPACTS

- This Program ensured that intelligent school boys faced no hindrance during board exams, allowing them to perform without worry.
- The program prevented these boys from being expelled due to financial constraints, ensuring uninterrupted education.
- RSKS India's support provided these boys with school fees, enabling them to study effectively and excel in their academics.
- With the financial burden lifted, these boys can now pursue their education without worries, fostering a conducive learning environment.
- RSKS India, by recognizing education as a fundamental right, played a crucial role in ensuring these children have the opportunity to study without hindrance.



In response to this pressing need, RSKS India took a decisive step to provide non-agricultural skills training, including beautician, handicrafts, and advanced garment making, to women and girls in rural and urban-rural areas.

This year, RSKS India successfully empowered **171 women and girls**, aged 18-35, hailing from five different rural areas and participating in various trades across five distinct batches. The Vocational Skill Educational School spanned 3-5 months, depending on the trade, with mandatory 5 hours of daily training.

The training encompassed both practical and theoretical aspects, with a distinctive feature being the inclusion of job fairs, life skills training, capacity building sessions, hat bazaars, exhibitions, and sports activities. These events aimed to truly empower and instill courage and confidence in the participants. At the conclusion of the training, skill certificates were awarded to honor the women and girls, providing valuable credentials for job opportunities or entrepreneurship.

Mobilizing these groups added stability to the project, forming skill net groups that conducted monthly meetings. These sessions facilitated discussions on employment opportunities, addressed challenges, and allowed for queries to be resolved by both the participants and the RSKS team members, fostering ongoing support and collaboration.

Sustainable Livelihood

RSKS India knows that economic and social empowerment work as a catalyst for enhancing women and girls, enabling them to make decisions that positively impact their health, wellbeing, and that of their families. Throughout the year, RSKS India successfully implemented the following programs aimed at dismantling economic and societal barriers and bringing women and girls to the forefront of societal progress:

BUILD BRIGHT FUTURE FOR MARGINALIZED GIRLS & WOMEN

In the contemporary landscape, acquiring skills is imperative for initiating self-employment or securing a job. Unfortunately, rural women and girls face challenges due to a lack of education and skills, hindering their ability to embark on new ventures despite their strong desire to financially support their families.





IMPACTS

- 171 girls and women learned the skills of beautician, garments making etc.
- 82% of these women became self reliant by doing starting self employment or doing job.
- The program reached women from five different rural areas, fostering inclusivity and skill development across diverse communities.
- Awarding skill certificates added value to the participants, enhancing their employability and providing a foundation for potential entrepreneurship.
- Formation of skill net groups and monthly meetings created a stable support system, addressing employment challenges and fostering ongoing collaboration.
- RSKS India's initiative provided vital non-agricultural skills, enabling 171 rural women and girls to pursue self-employment opportunities and secure jobs.
- Bridging the education and skill gap, the program addressed challenges faced by rural women and girls, empowering them to venture into new opportunities.
- Inclusion of job fairs, life skills training, capacity building, hat bazaars, exhibitions, and sports activities aimed at boosting confidence and courage among participants.





ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM FOR GIRLS & YOUNG WOMEN



Amidst the challenges posed by the pandemic, which constrained economic growth and led to unemployment, risk-aversion, and reduced non-essential consumption, RSKS India's Girls & Young Women's Entrepreneurship Development program played a pivotal role in empowering **171 young women and girls** in rural areas.

This initiative focused on nurturing both budding and existing women entrepreneurs, facilitating the launch, operation, and expansion of their businesses. RSKS India achieved this by sharing inspiring success stories, addressing queries, and rectifying gender imbalances within enterprise development.

The program aimed to amplify the impact of women entrepreneurs on growth and sustainable development, fostering their meaningful participation in entrepreneurship ecosystems. Through this, it not only empowered these girls and young women entrepreneurs but also facilitated job creation and eliminated barriers to establishing productive and sustainable businesses.



IMPACTS

- Fostering sustainable economies in rural areas, the initiative actively contributed to building resilience and long-term viability.
- Marked elevation in the engagement of young women and girls within employment and entrepreneurship ecosystems, creating avenues for meaningful participation.
- Remarkably improved the financial standings of over 90% of the participating girls, paving the way for enhanced economic independence.
- Cultivated self-reliance among these women and girls, transforming them into vital contributors to their family's well-being.
- Boosted confidence and courage among the program participants, empowering them to navigate challenges and pursue their aspirations.
- Emerged as inspiring role models, these girls and women set examples for others in rural areas, igniting aspirations and fostering positive change.





DISABILITY



Differently Abled people faces heightened challenges in accessing crucial resources such as rehabilitation, education, and employment, thereby exacerbating the struggle to break free from the relentless cycle of poverty. Recognizing the urgent need to address these issues, RSKS India is dedicated to empowering individuals with disabilities through comprehensive programs that focus on Empowerment, Education, Livelihood, Social & Health. By creating inclusivity and providing targeted support, RSKS India aims to create lasting positive changes in the lives of disabled individuals, empowering them to overcome barriers and achieve holistic well-being through the following program:



EMPOWERING PEOPLE LIVING WITH DISABILITIES

RSKS India is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life and expanding opportunities for individuals with disabilities. Currently, our efforts are focused on collaborating with over **450 individuals with disabilities** and children with disabilities across 16 villages in Ajmer.

This comprehensive program addresses the unique needs of people with disabilities of all ages, providing essential support and attention. Our dedicated team at RSKS ensures the well-being of children with disabilities through home-based activities, daily living exercises, and educational sessions covering vital skills such as recognizing colors, personal grooming, bathing, eating habits, and counting. The program, centered on Empowerment, Education, Livelihood, and Social & Health initiatives, has achieved impactful results this year, including:



HEALTH



- Conducted home-based activities and daily living exercises with 21 out of 35 Children with Disabilities (CwDs), involving their families.
- Provided equipment support to 7 Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) facing mobility challenges.
- Educated 28 out of 35 parents of CwDs on cleanliness and daily routines.
- Taught functional abilities to 19 out of 35 CwDs for self-care.
- Addressed malnutrition in 13 CwDs by providing nutritious food with the assistance of Anganwadi workers.
- Conducted medical check-ups for 36 differently-abled individuals.



EDUCATION



- Imparted educational teachings on touch, shape, and counting to 21 out of 35 CwDs.
- Mobilized volunteers from various schools to support CwDs in their education.
- Facilitated meetings with 25 school teachers to provide educational support for school-going CwDs.
- Organized monthly meetings for 5 Mother Supporting Groups.





LIVELIHOOD

- Provided training in different work to 10 PwDs, enabling them to earn a livelihood.
- Facilitated the creation of Aadhar and Jan Aadhar cards for 37 disabled individuals.
- Issued Disable Certificates / UDID cards for 36 disabled individuals and assisted in applying for disabled pensions.
- Generated special job cards for 15 disabled individuals.
- Facilitated the processing of disabled pensions for 32 disabled individuals.



EMPOWERMENT



- Involved disabled individuals at the panchayat level, ensuring their voices are heard.
- Shared information about government schemes during monthly DPO meetings.
- Disseminated knowledge about the RPWD Act to 325 PwDs and their families in approximately 16 rural villages.
- Empowered disabled individuals to assert their rights, providing follow-up support for inquiries lodged with various departments.



SOCIAL

- Motivated 324 PwDs through regular counseling, fostering active participation in social and family activities.
- Encouraged 298 PwDs to make independent decisions and communicate effectively with society.
- Conducted monthly meetings for over 8 Disabled People Organizations (DPOs), involving more than 150 participants.

As the interconnected web of life relies on nature for sustenance, the imperative of environmental protection has assumed unprecedented significance. RSKS India undertook a series of impactful initiatives throughout the year, dedicated to safeguarding our environment and fostering a global community committed to a sustainable future. In alignment with our mission to create a better world, we engaged in the following:

SAVE INNOCENT SPARROW BIRDS

In the present time, the once-thriving sparrow population faces a precarious decline, with some regions witnessing their gradual disappearance and nearing the brink of extinction. The factors contributing to this alarming trend include deforestation, the proliferation of mobile towers, the widespread use of pesticides and the encroachment of cemented structures all of which disrupt the natural habitats essential for these innocent sparrows.



In response to this situation, RSKS INDIA took proactive measures this year, conducting widespread awareness campaigns to educate approximately **1000 people** about the environmental benefits of preserving sparrow birds.

In response to this situation, RSKS INDIA took proactive measures this year, conducting Along with the awareness initiatives, RSKS INDIA implemented a comprehensive strategy by installing more than **248 eco-friendly bird houses and bird feeders** in public spaces, distributing them to bird and environment enthusiasts. This multifaceted approach aimed not only to raise awareness but also to provide tangible solutions to mitigate the challenges faced by sparrow birds.



IMPACTS

- Over 248 sparrow birds have found sanctuary in these eco-friendly bird houses.
- Within a remarkably short span of 1-2 weeks, the sparrow birds adeptly built their nests in these secure bird houses.
- A noticeable surge in the population of sparrow birds was observed, underscoring the positive impact of our conservation efforts.
- The wooden bird houses served as effective shields, providing protection to sparrow birds from potential threats posed by hunters.
- Nearby bird feeders ensured a readily available source of nourishment for the birds, contributing to their well-being and sustained presence.
- The success of our initiative drew the interest of numerous bird enthusiasts, leading to an influx of new admirers seeking bird houses from RSKS India.



ADOPT A TREE: PROTECT ENVIRONMENT & EARTH

Throughout the year, RSKS India extended its reach to **34 rural villages and locations**, imparting awareness to over **1300 individuals**, including school children, on the crucial need for environmental protection through tree adoption.



This educational outreach utilized various mediums such as flipcharts, story sessions, video presentations, flipbooks, and card sheets to effectively convey the importance of preserving our surroundings.

Building upon this awareness campaign, RSKS India took concrete steps by planting approximately **1600 fruitful and shade-providing trees**. Additionally, **1000 environment awareness notebooks** were distributed to school children, further reinforcing the commitment to fostering environmental consciousness from a young age.

The collaboration with local communities and school children not only facilitated RSKS India's contribution to environmental conservation but also inspired and encouraged others in these villages to play an active role. These strategically planted trees serve a multifaceted purpose, offering shade, oxygen, business opportunities, improved nutrition, and a brighter future for the children of these communities.

RSKS India remains dedicated to nurturing this positive environmental momentum, recognizing the profound impact it has on the well-being and sustainability of both communities and the planet at large.



IMPACTS

A G R I C U L T U R E & L I V E S T O C K



In response to the declining state of the agriculture sector, which has adversely impacted the livelihoods of numerous rural farmers, RSKS India has undertaken a multifaceted approach to provide comprehensive support to Agriculture and Livestock. Recognizing the pivotal role that agriculture plays in sustaining rural economies, RSKS India has implemented the following initiatives throughout the year:

EMPOWERING WOMEN WITH SUSTAINABLE LIVELIHOOD

RSKS India is actively addressing the challenges faced by rural women farmers in India by organizing impactful initiatives. Recognizing the critical role of agriculture in providing sustenance to the nation, RSKS India acknowledges the disparities faced by rural women farmers in accessing modern and efficient agricultural practices.

One such initiative involved the RSKS team RSKS India conceptualized an exposure visit and conducted a Five Days Animal Husbandry & Organic Fertilizers (Vermin Compost) Skill Development Training for Women Self Help Group (SHG) Members. A total of **75 SHG Members** participated in this program, where they received comprehensive training on Animal Husbandry, Organic Fertilizers and modern techniques.



The exposure visit, facilitated by experts, included practical demonstrations and insightful discussions to empower the women farmers with valuable insights. To enhance their understanding of the agricultural supply chain, the participants were taken to processing units. Understanding the financial constraints faced by rural women farmers, RSKS India went a step further by covering the traveling and food expenses for the participants. This thoughtful approach allowed the women farmers to focus solely on absorbing and implementing the new techniques they learned during the exposure visit.





IMPACTS

- RSKS India's initiatives empower rural women farmers by providing comprehensive training on Animal Husbandry, Organic Fertilizers, and modern agricultural techniques.
- A Five Days Skill Development Training for 75 Women Self Help Group (SHG) Members enhances their knowledge and skills in sustainable farming practices.
- The exposure visit, facilitated by experts, includes practical demonstrations, insightful discussions, and visits to processing units, equipping women farmers with valuable insights.
- RSKS India's support extends beyond training, covering traveling and food expenses, easing financial constraints for the participants.
- This thoughtful approach enables women farmers to focus on implementing new techniques, fostering the sustainable adoption of modern agricultural practices.
- The impacts ripple through individual livelihoods, contributing to the overall growth of the agricultural sector and empowering women in rural communities.

KITCHEN GARDEN SETUP FOR BETTER NUTRITION & LIVELIHOOD

In numerous rural regions of Rajasthan, a dearth of access to nutritious food and limited livelihood opportunities confronts marginalized farmers. Acknowledging these pressing issues, RSKS India undertook a proactive approach to tackle these challenges and foster sustainable nutrition and livelihoods through the implementation of the Kitchen Garden Set-Up program.

Diligently, the dedicated members of the RSKS team executed the Kitchen Garden Set-Up program, identifying 17 rural villages with marginalized farming communities, schools, and Anganwadi centers poised to benefit from this initiative. RSKS India facilitated this by distributing fertilizers, seeds, and farming materials to the **1387** identified beneficiaries.

The distributed fertilizers supplied essential nutrients, ensuring the optimal growth and nutritional value of the cultivated plants. RSKS India also conducted comprehensive training sessions and workshops for farmers, school staff, and anganwadi workers. These educational initiatives covered a range of topics, including organic farming techniques, composting, pest management, and effective harvesting practices.



IMPACTS

- RSKS India addressed food scarcity and limited livelihood opportunities in rural Rajasthan through the Kitchen Garden Set-Up program.
- The program identified and targeted 17 villages with marginalized farming communities, schools, and Anganwadi centers.
- Distribution of fertilizers, seeds, and farming materials to 1387 beneficiaries ensured optimal plant growth and nutritional value.
- Comprehensive training sessions and workshops covered organic farming, composting, pest management, and effective harvesting practices.
- The program empowered farmers, school staff, and anganwadi workers, fostering sustainable nutrition and livelihoods.

Child Rights & Welfare



Many children have been deprived of the joy of a traditional childhood, belonging to the impoverished segments of society, often residing in slums or on the streets. RSKS India has dedicated efforts to bring happiness to these children through the "Make A Wish For Street & Slum Children Project" throughout the year. The project encompasses various programs aimed at uplifting and bringing joy to these underprivileged youngsters which are as follows:



FESTIVALS CELEBRATION WITH SLUM & STREET CHILDREN



Slum and street children harbor the same desires to celebrate festivals as their counterparts from the mainstream of society. However, various reasons often prevent them from fulfilling these desires. RSKS India has played a pivotal role in making the heartfelt wishes of these children come true by organizing celebrations for festivals such as Holi, Dussehra, Diwali, and Christmas. Over **600 slum and street children** from approximately **24 locations** were given the opportunity to partake in these festivities, creating a sense of joy and inclusion.

The celebration programs included the distribution of 300 fancy dresses for girls, 300 Indo Western Sherwani dresses for boys, 600 packets of firecrackers, 600 T-light candles, 700 food packets, 600 packets of gulal, 600 water guns, 650 sweet packets, 500 color packets, 100 soft toys, Santa caps, hairbands, balloons, and more. The sparkle in the eyes of these children was evident as they celebrated the festivals with unabated joy and enthusiasm and learned about these festivals too.





IMPACTS

- RSKS India fulfilled the heartfelt wishes of over 600 slum and street children by organizing festive celebrations for Holi, Dussehra, Diwali, and Christmas.
- Through the distribution of 300 fancy dresses, 300 Indo Western Sherwani dresses, 600 firecrackers, and various other items, the organization created a sense of joy and inclusion.
- The celebration programs not only brought happiness but also imparted knowledge as children participated in plays, workshops, and story-telling sessions about the significance of these festivals.
- The sparkle in the eyes of these children was evident as they embraced the festivities with unabated joy and enthusiasm, experiencing a sense of belonging and happiness.
- The initiative touched the lives of slum and street children in 24 locations, providing them with an opportunity to celebrate like their counterparts in mainstream society.



NEW DRESSES, HYGIENE KIT & NUTRITIOUS FOOD AWARENESS & DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM



Children residing in slums often wear torn-out clothes and face health issues due to a lack of hygiene materials and nutritious food. Addressing these challenges, RSKS India, through the Make A Wish For Street & Slum Children project, initiated the New Dresses, Hygiene Kit & Nutritious Food Awareness & Distribution Program.

This impactful program fulfilled the dreams of over **600 slum and street children** across 25 locations, providing them with 1100 new dresses (Anarkali suits, jeans, cotton t-shirts, etc.), 600 sleeper sandals, 700 bhojan thalis, 1754 bakery food packets, 600 sweets, 600 nutritious food kits (Soyabean, Dalia, Moong Dal, Rajma, Whole Black Gram, etc.), and 600 hygiene kits (big bucket, comb, bathing soap set, toothpaste, toothbrush, hair oil bottle, bathing mug, etc.).

All these initiatives were executed with strict adherence to social distancing guidelines. The program not only brought joy to the slum and street children, making them dance and sing with happiness but also raised awareness about nutrition and a healthy diet.



IMPACTS

- RSKS India's New Dresses, Hygiene Kit & Nutritious Food Program addressed the challenges faced by slum children, providing them with essential items.
- The program impacted over 600 children in 25 locations, fulfilling their dreams with 1100 new dresses, 600 sleeper sandals, and various other necessities.
- Executed with strict adherence to social distancing, the initiative not only brought joy to children but also raised awareness about nutrition and healthy living.
- The distribution of 700 bhojan thalis, 1754 bakery food packets, 600 sweets, and nutritious food kits contributed to improved health and well-being.
- Educational activities like snake & ladder games and story-telling enhanced awareness about the importance of hygiene and a nutritious diet among slum and street children.

VALUE BASED EDUCATION CAMPS



Slum and street children develop different type of bad habits due to lack of awareness and education, this makes them often stemming from a lack of education on discipline, moral values, and essential life skills. Recognizing this issue, RSKS India took proactive measures this year by organizing Value-Based Education Camps in 26 different slum and street areas where such incidents were prevalent.

These camps saw the active participation of more than **600 slum and street children** who engaged in educational activities like flipcharts, story-telling sessions, flipbooks, snake & ladder games, and video shows. The aim was to instill essential values and life skills in these children, motivating them to respect their elders and learn proper behavior.

Moreover, parents from the slum and street communities actively brought their children to these camps, where they received valuable information on topics such as good touch-bad touch, education, life skills, and discipline. Through these initiatives, RSKS India sought to empower and educate these children, fostering a positive and informed environment within these communities.



IMPACTS

- RSKS India's Value-Based Education Camps addressed the root causes of bad habits among slum and street children, stemming from a lack of awareness and education on discipline and moral values.
- Over 600 children actively participated in the camps, engaging in educational activities like flipcharts, story-telling sessions, flipbooks, snake & ladder games, and video shows.
- The objective was to instill essential values and life skills, motivating the children to respect elders and adopt proper behavior, contributing to positive behavioral changes.
- Parents in slum and street communities actively participated, gaining valuable insights on crucial topics like good touch-bad touch, education, life skills, and discipline for the holistic development of their children.
- RSKS India's initiatives aimed to empower and educate children, creating a positive and informed environment within these communities and breaking the cycle of negative habits.

EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT TO SLUM & STREET CHILDREN



In our ongoing commitment to creating positive social impact, RSKS India has actively addressed the critical issue of education deprivation among slum and street children. RSKS India's dedicated team undertook a comprehensive initiative by organizing six-day education camps across eight different slum and street locations. More than **150 children** participated in these camps, marking a significant step towards breaking the cycle of poverty and providing these children with an opportunity for a brighter future. The meticulous process involved four levels of consultations over a period of 90 days. The first level engaged directly with the children, understanding their unique challenges and aspirations.



Subsequently, the second level involved consultations with parents, addressing concerns and fostering support for their children's education. Moving forward, the third level engaged with the wider community to ensure a collective commitment to education, emphasizing its transformative power. The fourth and final level involved collaboration with local schools, establishing a seamless integration for the children into the mainstream educational system.



The outcome of this comprehensive approach was profound, with **71 slum and street children** successfully linked to formal education. RSKS India team visited the schools where these children were enrolled, honoring them in a special ceremony and provided them the educational materials they needed for their studies.

IMPACTS



- RSKS India's focused initiative addressed the critical issue of education deprivation among slum and street children, offering them a chance for a brighter future.
- Through six-day education camps in eight locations, more than 150 children were engaged, breaking the cycle of poverty and providing a pathway to formal education.
- A meticulous process of four levels of consultations over 90 days ensured a comprehensive approach, involving children, parents, the community, and local schools.
- The outcome was profound, with 71 children successfully linked to formal education, breaking free from hazardous work and gaining the opportunity for empowerment.
- RSKS India celebrated this achievement with a special ceremony, honoring the enrolled children and fostering a positive attitude towards education.
- To support their educational journey, RSKS India provided essential education materials, ensuring a seamless integration into the world of learning.
- This initiative exemplifies RSKS India's commitment to addressing social disparities at their roots and creating a future where every child has the opportunity to break free from the cycle of poverty through education.





WARM TRACKSUIT, WOOLEN CAP, WARM HAND GLOVES & DELICIOUS FOOD PACKETS DISTRIBUTION & AWARENESS ABOUT HEALTH & EDUCATION DURING WINTER PROGRAM

RSKS India undertook a comprehensive initiative to provide essential care and support to children residing in slum and street environments. Recognizing the harsh realities of their daily lives, where inadequate clothing compounded the challenges of weather variations, RSKS India team intervened to make a meaningful impact on the lives of 600 children across 25 slum and street locations.

The initiative began with a targeted awareness campaign focused on health and education for these underserved children. RSKS India also took a proactive step by providing essential winter items to the 600 children. Each child received a package comprising a warm tracksuit, woolen cap, crocs set, warm hand gloves set, and a delicious food packet containing special treats such as laddu, til laddu, lai, etc. This comprehensive support was designed not only to shield them from the harsh weather conditions but also to bring a sense of comfort and dignity to their lives.



IMPACTS

- RSKS India's initiative addressed the pressing needs of 600 children in slum and street environments, recognizing the challenges they face daily.
- A targeted awareness campaign on health and education was launched to empower and uplift underserved children.
- Proactively providing essential winter items, each child received a package with warm clothing and a delicious food packet, enhancing their well-being.
- The initiative aimed not only to shield the children from harsh weather conditions but also to bring comfort and dignity to their lives.

Addressing one of the myriad challenges in India's healthcare sector, the accessibility gap to quality services for impoverished and marginalized communities has persisted. For three decades, RSKS India has been steadfast in its commitment to overcoming these challenges. This year, we did the following impactful work:

BE FREE: HAPPY PERIOD WITH SANITARY NAPKINS

There is Concerning lack of healthy menstruation practices among rural, slum, and street women and girls, leading to potential harm. Throughout the year, RSKS India has dedicated efforts to instigate a positive habit change among these women and girls. Our focus has been on spreading awareness about healthy menstruation practices, complemented by the distribution of **7850 sanitary napkins** to **3809 women** and girls across **112** different locations and villages.

RSKS India actively mobilized these women and girls, facilitating a comprehensive understanding of sexual and reproductive health, emphasizing the importance of healthy menstruation. Utilizing engaging tools such as aprons, video stories, consultations, flipcharts, and card sheets, we aimed to empower these individuals with knowledge that can contribute to their overall well-being.

IMPACTS

- RSKS India's efforts addressed a concerning lack of healthy menstruation practices among rural, slum, and street women and girls, mitigating potential harm.
- A positive habit change was instigated throughout the year, focusing on spreading awareness about healthy menstruation practices.
- The distribution of 7850 sanitary napkins to 3809 women and girls across 112 locations significantly contributed to promoting menstrual hygiene.
- Active mobilization by RSKS India ensured a comprehensive understanding of sexual and reproductive health, emphasizing the importance of healthy menstruation.
- Engaging tools such as aprons, video stories, consultations, flipcharts, and card sheets were utilized to empower women and girls with knowledge, contributing to their overall well-being.





NUTRITION FOOD PACKET DISTRIBUTION TO SERIOUS PATIENTS SUFFERING FROM T.B.

In the face of life-threatening tuberculosis, a healthy diet and proper medications are crucial for recovery. In the past year, RSKS India has extended support to **35 MDR & XDR tuberculosis patients** by ensuring they have access to proper protein-rich nutritious food every month. The nutrition food packets provided by RSKS India contain essentials such as soybeans, eggs, rajma, oats, black gram, promoting a healthy and speedy recovery for these patients.

The beneficiaries include daily wage workers, laborers, painters, marginal farmers, and mine workers—individuals whose financial constraints often prevent them from accessing proper nutritious food. RSKS India, recognizing this critical need, not only provided nutritional support but also diligently tracked the progress of these patients until their recovery, ensuring a sustained commitment to their well-being.

IMPACTS

- RSKS India's support has had a significant impact on 35 MDR & XDR tuberculosis patients, emphasizing the importance of a healthy diet for recovery.
- Monthly provision of nutrition food packets, including soybeans, eggs, rajma, oats, and black gram, has contributed to a healthy and speedy recovery for these patients.
- Beneficiaries, including daily wage workers, laborers, painters, marginal farmers, and mine workers, faced financial constraints that hindered access to nutritious food; RSKS India addressed this critical need.
- The initiative goes beyond providing nutritional support, with RSKS India diligently tracking the progress of patients until their recovery, ensuring a sustained commitment to their well-being.





KILL MALARIA SAVE HUMAN LIFE

*Annually, a significant number of lives worldwide are lost to mosquito-borne diseases, primarily because of insufficient awareness about these diseases and the lack of knowledge on mosquito protection measures. In response to this global health challenge, RSKS India organized a Mass Awareness Program on the Prevention and Treatment of Mosquito-Borne Diseases, complemented by the distribution of mosquito nets to street, slum, and nomadic families. This impactful program reached **503 families** and approximately **2000 family members** across **20** different slum and street locations.*

*Through engaging methods such as charts, a snake ladder game, stories, and flipcharts, RSKS India successfully raised awareness about the importance of preventing and treating mosquito-borne diseases. Additionally, **400 mosquito nets** were distributed to nomadic families, providing a vital barrier against disease-carrying mosquitoes. The program not only offered tangible support in the form of mosquito nets but also educated participants on preventive measures and treatments for mosquito-borne diseases. The goal was to empower individuals to protect themselves and their families from these life-threatening diseases caused by mosquitoes.*

IMPACTS

- RSKS India's Mass Awareness Program impacted 503 families and around 2000 family members across 20 different slum and street locations.
- Engaging methods such as charts, a snake ladder game, stories, and flipcharts effectively raised awareness about the prevention and treatment of mosquito-borne diseases.
- The distribution of 400 mosquito nets to nomadic families served as a vital barrier, protecting them from disease-carrying mosquitoes.
- Beyond tangible support, the program educated participants on preventive measures, empowering them to safeguard themselves and their families from life-threatening mosquito-borne diseases.





IMPACTS

- RSKS India's Warm Blanket Distribution program impacted 250 homeless, poor, street, and nomadic individuals, providing crucial warmth during harsh winter conditions.
- The initiative addressed the vulnerability of these individuals to sickness due to cold weather, offering a tangible solution to combat the winter chill.
- Poor financial circumstances that often hindered access to necessary resources were alleviated through the distribution of warm blankets.
- The program, implemented across 11 different locations, demonstrated RSKS India's commitment to extending essential support to vulnerable populations during challenging weather conditions.
- By equipping individuals with vital resources, such as warm blankets, RSKS India contributed to their well-being and protection against illness throughout the winter months.

WARM BLANKET DISTRIBUTION TO STREET, NOMADIC, POOR PEOPLE DURING WINTER

In the unforgiving grip of winter, individuals living on streets or roads—those who are homeless, nomadic, or impoverished—face the harshness of the cold breeze. The cold weather exacerbates their vulnerability, often resulting in sickness. Unfortunately, their poor financial circumstances hinder them from acquiring the necessary means to combat the winter chill.

*To address this pressing issue, RSKS India implemented the Warm Blanket Distribution To Poor, Street, And Nomadic People During Winter program. This initiative provided warmth and comfort to **250 homeless, poor, street, and nomadic individuals** across 11 different locations. Through the distribution of warm blankets, RSKS India aimed to equip these individuals with a vital resource, enabling them to withstand the cold weather and safeguard themselves from illness during the winter months.*





WARM WOOLEN UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION TO NEEDY KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS DURING WINTER

In rural areas, particularly among underprivileged families, children often experience a lack of basic necessities, including clothing, shoes, and socks. This disparity was evident in a rural Anganbadi school, where children were deprived even of essential items like clothing, shoes, and socks. In response to this critical need, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan initiated a Dress, Shoes, and Socks Distribution Program at an Anganbadi. This initiative provided clothing, shoes, and socks to **37 children** at two Anganbadis, ensuring they received the essential items they needed the most.

IMPACTS

- RSKS's Dress, Shoes, and Socks Distribution Program addressed the prevalent lack of basic necessities among underprivileged children in rural areas.
- Little Children got warmth in the harsh winter.
- The initiative targeted a rural Anganbadi school where children were deprived of essential items such as clothing, shoes, and socks.
- RSKS India provided clothing, shoes, and socks to 37 children at two Anganbadis, alleviating their pressing need for these essential items.





TARPAULIN SHELTER RELIEF TO THE SLUM DWELLERS, NOMADIC & STREET FAMILIES DURING THE HARSH RAINFALL FOR SAFE HAVEN

RSKS India demonstrated exemplary humanitarian efforts through the implementation of the Tarpaulin Shelter Relief initiative, providing a secure refuge for 30 vulnerable populations amidst harsh rainfall. The focus of this initiative was on slum dwellers, nomadic communities, and families residing on the streets—groups particularly exposed to the unforgiving elements. The strategically deployed tarpaulin shelters served as a temporary haven, offering protection from the inclement weather and safeguarding the safety and well-being of these individuals.



IMPACTS

- RSKS India's Tarpaulin Shelter Relief initiative showcased humanitarian excellence, providing secure refuge for 30 vulnerable populations during harsh rainfall.
- The initiative specifically targeted slum dwellers, nomadic communities, and families on the streets, offering a temporary haven against the unforgiving elements.
- The strategically deployed tarpaulin shelters served as a vital protective barrier, ensuring the safety and well-being of individuals facing the challenges of inclement weather.
- This impactful work reflects RSKS India's commitment to immediate relief efforts, demonstrating a dedication to uplifting and safeguarding marginalized communities.





FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE & MATERIALS DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM FOR AUSPICIOUS MARRIAGE OF HELPLESS, ORPHAN AND DEPRIVED COMMUNITY GIRLS

In addressing the emotional and psychological distress experienced by orphans following the loss of their parents, and needy rural girls who are facing financial problems, RSKS India initiated the Support To **3 Orphan/Needy Poor Rural Girls** For their Auspicious Wedding at 3 different villages. The team conducted a baseline survey at the girl's residence and, before her marriage, delivered a generous array of gifts, including home appliances, utensils, blankets, and other daily essentials.

To maintain transparency and involve the community, the village administration and neighbors were invited to the program to provide blessings to the girl. The team members took the opportunity to explain the utility of each item, offering their best wishes for her marriage.

IMPACTS

- RSKS India's Support To 3 Orphan/Needy Poor Rural Girl For Their Auspicious Wedding initiative extended emotional and financial support to three vulnerable girls in different villages.
- Through baseline surveys at the girls' residences, the team identified their unique needs, delivering thoughtful gifts like home appliances, utensils, blankets, and daily essentials before their marriages.
- The inclusion of the village administration and neighbors in the program enhanced transparency and community involvement, ensuring collective blessings for the girls.
- Team members played a pivotal role in explaining the utility of each item, contributing to the girls' understanding and appreciation, and offering heartfelt best wishes for their upcoming marriages.

RATION/GROCERY PACKETS & HYGIENE KIT DISTRIBUTION TO NEEDY FAMILIES



Nutrition is a fundamental necessity for every individual, and the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic left numerous people grappling with unemployment and depleted savings, resulting in food security challenges. Identifying these vulnerable individuals across 19 different villages, slums, and streets, RSKS India took decisive action to bring joy into their lives through the distribution of Ration/Grocery Packets.

In a comprehensive humanitarian effort, RSKS India provided food relief to over **1,010 families**, ensuring the food security of approximately **4,000 family members** with a total of **30,300 kg of Ration/Grocery**. This initiative not only brought comfort to thousands of lives but also addressed the critical aspects of proper nutrition and hygiene.

DISASTER RELIEF

The global community grappled with the devastating impact of the novel coronavirus. Countless individuals faced the loss of livelihoods, lives, and hope, while the economy experienced significant upheaval. RSKS India team strategically devised and implemented a series of programs under the Together We Can 3.0 Campaign and the Covid-19 Humanitarian Relief Project. These initiatives were designed to safeguard and provide livelihood opportunities to the individuals. This year we did the following work to provide relief to the communities affected:



FERTILIZERS, SEEDS & FARMING MATERIAL DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM FOR BETTER AGRICULTURAL LIVELIHOOD TO MARGINAL FARMERS



The aftermath of the pandemic continues to be disastrous for many, particularly those who have lost their primary sources of income. The rural populace, now facing financial crises, looks to agriculture as a means of sustenance, yet lacks the resources to invest in seeds, fertilizers, and pesticides.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, attuned to the struggles of these communities, responded proactively through the Fertilizer, Seeds & Farming Material Distribution Program for Better Agricultural Livelihood To Marginal Farmers. **40 Rural Marginal farmers** received an Agriculture Livelihood Kit, comprising essential components such as Organic Fertilizer Manure Packet (10 KG), Millet Seed (6 KG), Peanut Seed (6 KG), Corn Seed (7 KG), Gaur Seed (7 KG), Coriander Seed (5 KG), etc.

IMPACTS

- The distribution of Agriculture Livelihood Kits contributed to increased crop yields among 40 rural marginal farmers.
- The inclusion of Organic Fertilizer Manure Packets encouraged the adoption of eco-friendly and sustainable farming methods.
- The program alleviated financial burdens by providing essential farming resources, enabling farmers to sustain themselves and their families.
- By addressing the immediate needs of farmers, the program contributed to enhanced food security within the targeted communities.
- The initiative served as a proactive response to the economic fallout of the pandemic, mitigating the crisis for vulnerable rural populations.

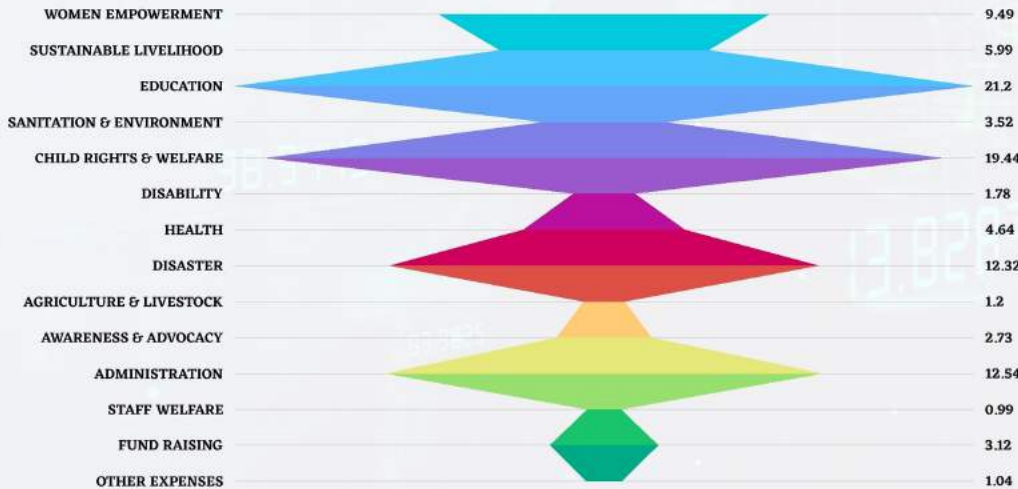

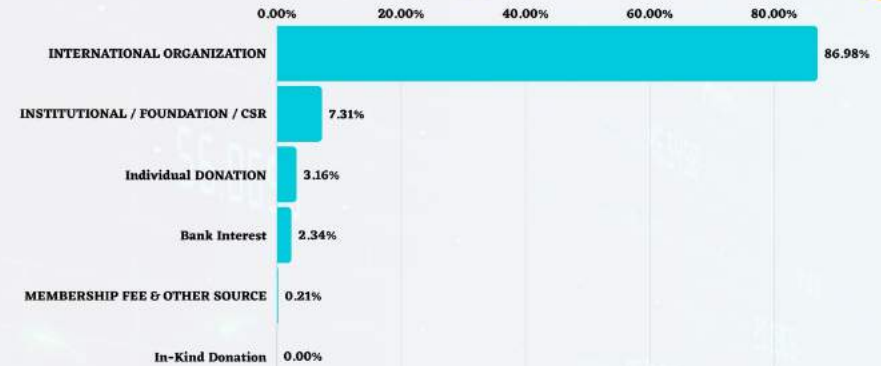
