Thank you for your continued partnership with Days for Girls and for standing with refugee women and girls in Lebanon. We are pleased to share an update celebrating the completion of our most recent project.

Project Completion: Reaching 900 Refugee Women and Girls



In our last report, we shared that the Days for Girls Social Enterprise in Lebanon was actively implementing a project to reach **900 refugee women and girls** across North Lebanon, Akkar, and Tripoli. We are happy to report that this project has now been **successfully completed**.

The project included the **local production of 900 Days for Girls washable pad Kits (DfG Kits)**, followed by distribution alongside delivery of Days for Girls' **signature menstrual health education**, our Ambassador of Women's Health curriculum. Both the DfG Kits and the education were extremely well received by refugee women and girls navigating

menstrual health within a displacement context.



As with all our work in Lebanon, this project was led by a Social Enterprise team, composed primarily of refugee women. Their leadership, care, and commitment ensured that menstrual health support was delivered with dignity, cultural relevance, and trust.

Looking Ahead to 2026

As we embark on 2026, we are currently in the process of designing the next phase of our work in Lebanon. This project is envisioned as a continuation of the 2025 initiative, building on the same community relationships, local

production model, and education-first approach.

While final figures are still being confirmed, our preliminary goal is to again reach **approximately 900 refugee women and girls** with DfG Kits and education in 2026. We will share more details as plans are finalized and funding levels are confirmed.
