








































We women foundation is an organisation delivering against the UN's Sustainable Development Goal 5: Achieve gender equality: Empower all women and girls

We women foundations programmes help:

- Ensure women's full and effective participation and equal opportunities for leadership at all levels of decision-making in political, economic and public life
- Adopt and strengthen sound policies and enforceable legislation for the promotion of gender equality and the empowerment of all women and girls at all levels

Here's what we do to make change a reality



Scholarship

We provide scholarships to enable women to complete tertiary education. Each scholarship runs on the understanding that women will return to their region to take an active leadership role to be the change for the future.



Business and project development

Our recently launched programme in Myanmar provides training to develop the project management, bussiness management, and executive-level skills of women. This unique program provides an opportunity for women from maraginalised communities to build upon their strenghts and entrepenurial skills



We create strong multi-discipline networks across the ethnic areas in Myanmar and link them together at a national level to give them one single strong voice together – more powerful for influencing and working for change!

She was a *We women* pre-University student studying for the TOEFL exam, she found a scholarship sponsor herself and continued as an in-University *We women* student, she graduated with an MBA in January 2014.

In my home town, business is based mainly on agriculture; there are no other opportunities and there are not enough jobs for individuals or families without land or resources. It is my dream to develop local businesses for local people, and in so doing, build human capacity for the entire nation

How your company can help?

MATCHING GRANT: As part of the campaign launch, *We women* is looking for three corporate sponsors to provide funding for a matching grant challenge.

The sponsor would agree to match every donation *We women* receives within a certain time period (and up to a certain amount).

This is an extremely effective method to attract new supporters, encourage existing donors to continue their support, and to motivate people to spread the word.

People can see their donations going twice as far. Corporate sponsors also have the benefit of being featured prominently and can see how their support is able to leverage additional gifts for the organisation. The time sensitive nature of the challenge is important in motivating immediate gifts.

Time Period: 7st of December 2015 – 7st of January 2016

Matching Grant Amount Requested: €5,000 / €10,000

Choose one of the following:

Single Matching: Every donation is matched up to €5,000 or €10,000– a \$10 donation becomes a \$20 donation

Double Matching: Every donation is matched twice up to €5,000 or €10,000 – a \$10 donation becomes a \$30 donation
