

4. Family Counseling Center

In order to solve family conflicts, stress and problems, the NGO has established a counseling center at Hingoli. The center is getting good response. Every year on an average 25 Clients visit the center.

5. Child Labour Prevention Program

In order to check child labour, especially among the poor communities, the NGO motivates parents to put their children in schools, through meetings and child labour prevention campaigns.

6. Computer and Tailoring

A computer center has been established by the NGO at Latur for girls and women. The NGO has been able to impart computer and tailoring knowledge to 500 women and girls.
