## 6 Sewing machines to under privileged women



Beneficiaries under this project are trained through our course in tailoring skills. During this training, beneficiaries learned and developed skills in making shirts, trousers, skirts, school uniforms, south indian traditional wear such as: blouse, petticoat, trousers and shirts

At the end of the skills empowerment training, we at CHHASE found out 6 women, who are unable to buy tailoring machines because of their inability.

They are unable to find employment in an established tailoring business or unable to go for work because of their family problems such small children, nobody is there to look after these children.

And more ever two are widows with 2 children, living lonely made their life miserable to earn a daily bread.

A sewing machine, to begin self-employment at their homes, can give them a daily income and can able buy necessary medicines and capable to pay school fee for their children..

A sewing machine can give these 6 under privileged below poverty women a real meaningful life, save their children and secured life to them
