Safe Community Prevention Project

The Safe Community prevention project trains and works with government officials, religious leaders, teachers, NGO workers and community leaders in both rural and urban areas to raise awareness on prevention of trafficking and exploitation in their communities, how to report cases and proper case follow up. These community leaders become key points of contact for Chab Dai, and go on to train members of and raise awareness in their own communities. This model of prevention is crucial to seeing long-term change in Cambodia by investing in and empowering in community-led, organic and sustainable safety networks that are devoted in the wellbeing of their community members.

Safe Community also conducts a radio program on issues of human trafficking, sexual abuse, safe migration and children's rights with the aim to reach the most remote areas of Cambodia and raise awareness on these points for better prevention and protection of vulnerable communities.

In 2015, Safe Community project trained 1,512 village leaders in two provinces and worked directly with churches and public schools.
