#### The Goal: Caring for Orphans of Ebola

The Ebola outbreak in Sierra Leone has finally started to diminish. But as the disease fades, it is leaving tragedy in its wake.

In Sierra Leone, an estimated 8,000 children have lost one or both parents to Ebola, according to the United Nations. These children are often rejected by friends and relatives, who fear they carry Ebola. With no one to care for them, the children are left to fend for themselves. With your help, Children of the Nations (COTN) is providing a temporary home for these orphaned children, until they are connected with extended family or other caregivers.



#### The Need: A Home for Orphans

Through the support of generous partners like you, COTN is renovating its school in Freetown to accommodate up to 50 orphaned children. Our staff is adding toilets, sinks, beds, and other furnishings, turning the second floor of the school into a temporary home for children orphaned by Ebola.

These children will live in the home for up to one year, receiving the same holistic care all our children receive. If suitable families cannot be found, we will take the children into our Children's Homes in Banta, Sierra Leone.
