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Purpose

Educating the Slum Children

for the mass education of the children in the slums of the world. It can be used to

One classroom

DoPeace education is based on one-classroom in one community of 300 to 500 families. The criteria of selection of the location is 5 classes per day in one classroom.

Additional location criteria

1. Enough children ages 4.5 to 5.5 years old available to admit 90 children
2. Enough primary schools to admit 120 students (30 students each in grades 2-5) for coaching
3. Enough primary schools for admission of 90 DoPeace Learning Center graduates in grade 1

Model has 2 components

Everyday (6 days a week):

1. Preschool education (3 classes)
2. Coaching (2 classes)

A total of 5 classes a day.

The student population

1. Each preschool - Three sessions of 30 students per class (Saturday to Thursday)
2. Coaching consists of 2 sessions
 - a. Session 1: Saturday, Monday, Wednesday (30 students)
 - b. session 2: Sunday, Tuesday, Thursdays (30 students)

Standard Model

3 preschool + 2 coaching = 5 classes

1. Preschool: $3 \times 30 = 90$ students/day
2. Coaching: $2 \times 30 = 60$ students/day or 120 per week

Total: 210 per week

Educational goals

1. Absence: 5% average
2. Admission: 100% preschool admission to grade 1
3. Coaching grades: A level
4. Drop Out: To be brought back in one week
5. Parent & community meeting: Once a month

Reporting requirement

1. Student list at the time of admission
2. Daily attendance
3. Weekly pictures of each class
4. Parent & community meeting notes and pictures
5. Social Media reporting (Facebook, twitter, instagram, LinkedIn)
6. Allow random visit by DoPeace representative
7. Skype meeting with DoPeace representative
