

Stop Violence Against Women in India

Approximately, 27933 cases against "violence against women" are registered every year in police stations of the state Rajasthan, India. Under the project, the miserable women in rural and urban

regions that are victims of violence, outrage, dowry, exploitation & victimization are getting support by Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the help of Global Giving UK. The victims are being rehabilitated by counselling and skill development training as well as the awareness message for the eradication of violence against women is also being delivered to the male dominated society on a large scale by rally, workshops, seminars, road shows, puppet shows, signature campaign, poster-wall painting, oath taking programs.

Women self help group program

The project is being organised in 150 villages at present and under the project, more than 500 women self help groups are bein managed successfully. The groups are engaged to build capability, saving, confidence and financial capability in poor women and the members of the groups are made aware of education, health, child marriage, women right and other sensitive issues. More than 5000 poor women have been provided a loan of Rs.11 crore by banks for their economic development, meeting social needs, child education.

Empowering poor women with sustainable livelihood

The project is an effective initiative in the direction of economic empowerment of poor, landless, BPL, marginalized women. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the support of Global Giving Foundation, has successfully organising the project in the rural area of Pisangan, Ajmer. Under the project, a significant effort is being taken to provide better livelihood to poor women by associating them with agricultural and non-agricultural activities. Poor deprived women are being associated with women self help groups and with the support of banks, loans are sanctioned for their self-



employment which gets them better livelihood and builds up their confidence. Thus, deprived women are becoming empowered.



The other two vulnerabilities: occupational and social can be best addressed by creating opportunities for skill development leading to market based employment and helping them to set up self employment ventures. Urban poverty alleviation program need to base on skill development and easy access to credit.

Rehabilitation, Social and economic development for engaged in the Illegal manufacture of wine storage

Sansi, Kanjar, Bagariya and many other backward communities are involved in the production and sales of wine illegaly. To get them in the mainstream of the society, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan and the department of Social Justice and Empowerment, jointly, have been organising "Navjeevan" effectively in Beawar, 62 kms. far from Ajmer. Under this project, families which are involved in the production of wine illegaly are being made self-supporting by vocational training as well as awareness of ill effects of alcohol is being developed among the backward community. Under the project, women are being trained in food processing, sewing, beauty parlour, bag making and men are getting trained in as motor mechanic, motor driver, electician, mobile repairing, plumber and security gaurd.

Roshania initiative of empowering adolescents girls with Skills.

In this program, by skill development training, equal opportunities for better calling, employment/self-employment are being provided to girls of 15-24 age group of marginalized and deprived community in remote & small villages of block Peesangan, Ajmer. These deprived girls are being taught better (both theory and practical) so many skill development activities as computer education, handicraft, health nurse, garment & bag making and beautician course by specialists. The girls are also getting knowledge of marketing, packaging in the program. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, through this program, is also organising job fare for the trainees to get them better jobs. The girls, being proficient by training, are improving the living standard of their family.

Education

Pathshaala: - Back to school.....quality education for indigent children

The project "Pathshaala . . . back to school" is bein managed by Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan to provide quality education to poor deprived students. In addition to quality education, poor deprived children are being taught basic learnings of discipline, cleanliness, English under the project.

Objective

- » To increase enrolment of students in the school
- » To initiate the community to advocate for the poor children to have access to education
- » To increase the access of poor children to education
- » To change the life condition of poor girls and boys through education
- » To empower their families economically

Financial literacy and Inclusion program

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the support of National Bank of Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD), under the guidance of Central Cooperative Bank, is managing the program in approximately 80 remote villages to provide public with information about financial capability, banking, financial literacy & incorporation and insurance in non-banking villages. The villagers are being provided the information by street shows, puppet shows, road shows, choupal and video representations by the program. In



addition to this, banking and insurance consultation is also being provided to the villagers at the spot absolutely free as well as KYC insurance and saving accounts of the villagers are also opened under the program.

Study material distribution program

Rajsthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with the support of Global Giving Foundation, is managing the program in Ajmer to help poor and needy studetns. Under the project, study material as pen, books, pencils, colors, note books, uniform, sweater, school shoes, stationery kit are being provided to poor talented students as well as school fee of poor needy students is also being depositted under the project.

Objective

The main objectives of the program is to provide equal opportunities for education to 5000 poor deprived school kids by distributing study material among them and make those kids and their parents awared towards the importance of education.



Disaster/Recovery & Management

Nepal Relief Campaign

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan and Global Giving Foundation, jointly, organised "Nepal Relief Campaign" for the victims of Nepal earthquake in which relief camps were organised in the remote and distant villages Ekal Singha and Jeevanpur of the country of mountains, Nepal and the victim families were also provided relief in Bhaktpur and Kathmandu. Ration (dry wheat, rice, poha, biscuits), warm clothes, blankets, mosquito nets, solar lights were distributed to 177 victim families of the earthquake under the project. Besides that, study material (pen, pencil, book, color set, note book, geometry box, etc.) and biscuits were distributed to 85



children. The project organised for the sake of mankind was appreciated by the entire Nepal. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan has been successful so far in providing effective relief to the victims of the earthquake by the program.

Objective

The only objective of the project was to provide relief supplies to homeless victim families of the neighbouring country of mountains, Nepal for the sake of mankind.

Demand of the project



25th April, 2015 brought the means of destruction of the neighbouring country, Nepal. The destructive earthquake of magnitude 7.8 in Nepal took 11000 persons to death and made thousands of children orphan and homeless. The children had lost their parents' support from their life. Thousands of women became widow. The view of destruction can be seen everywhere in Nepal which can't be expressed in words. During and after the earquake, there was the problem of bread, clothes, house and other basic requirements for the victims had arisen. There was the possibility of spreading the epidemic.

- 2. 9 relief camps were organised in different earthquake affected area.
- 3. 85 children got relief by study material and food supply.
- 4. Almost 35 volunteers were associated to the project.
- 5. The campaign was appreciated by the entire Nepal.
- 6. The earthquake victims had believe in mankind and humanity.

Environment & Sanitation

Clean India Campaign

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is managing clean India campaign by the inspiration of Mr. Narendra Modi, the popular prime minister of India and "rashtrapita" Mahatma Gandhi. Taking this significant initiative, public is being aware of cleanliness by public rally, workshop, road show and posters. School kids are becoming disciplined towards cleanliness by handwash and poster competitions. Apart from this, drainages, wells, roads and handpump are also cleaned from time to time under the campaign. The villagers are motivated not to practice open defecation and to get lavatory build in house and use them.

RSKS has organized Farmer Club Program in the block of Peesangan and Ajmer, the objective of the program is development through credit, technology transfer, awareness and capacity building. The emphasis of the program is on increasing the income of the farmers by increasing the production & productivity by adopting appropriate technology, good agricultural practise, proper use of credit and marketing skills



Objective

- To organize training program for skill development for increased productivity & income level in all
 - activities for all people socially and economically weak, poorest of the poor in the club villages
- · To assist the Bank linkage
- To meet at regular intervals to discover/identify the Credit and non credit needs of farmers and fellow villagers.

Vermi composting

Organic waste, a challenge for disposal, a serious environmental pollutant, and a great social nuisance can be converted, using simple techniques, into useful and valuable product known as 'Vermi compost'. 'Vermi compost' is an organic form of fertilizer with all beneficial properties of inorganic fertilizer but is free from the harmful effects on soil and human health. In recent past with popularity of organic farming gaining, demand for organic fertilizers is increasing. The scope for betterment of soil health using vermin compost and globalization of our economy has opened up new vistas of business opportunity to commercially produce this commodity of multiple social and economic values.



Objective

- To make each farm holding self sufficient in its organic manure requirement thus reducing cost of cultivation of various crops.
- Promoting organic farming through the use of organic manures such as vermicompost and reduced dependence on chemical inputs
- iii. To provide opportunities for generating additional income to the farmers/youth through sale of compost, earthworms and vermiwash.
- iv. Upscale the use of vermin composting technology. f
- v. Reduce the amount of waste to be land filled.
- vi. To enhance income of farmers

In the block of Peesangan Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan has started Joint Liability Group Formation Program with financial support off NABARD. Under this project development and strengthen rural poor women and men belonging from rural society & have working with some micro enterprises for their livelihood, more than third farmers belong to small and marginal category NABARD supported JLG program is especially for those small and marginal farmers who do not have their own agriculture land or have very small holding size. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan

Sansthan organized 5-6 members & formed small group as joint liability group (JLG) as per their homogeneity base factors & we trained them in group functioning opening of group account in bank & then we provide hand holding support to establish financial linkages with the bank for strengthening of their micro enterprises for increase their income. After bank finance Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan Follow – ups with groups & motivated of facilitate & motivate them for repayment of Bank loan RSKS India formed 90 number of JLG's in diffrent village's of block peesagan of Ajmer distric in which we provide financial support to 57 JLG's. linkages with Bank for the development of their farm and non farm activity & increase their income support. up to till date the has been funded up to 94-25 lakh to the JLG's.

Case Study

Anjana Mahawar, a 31-years old Dalit girl was unemployed some time ago. One day she got a hope all of a sudden when she was selected as a trainee from her locality, slum of Nagra for handicraft vocational education by RSKS, supported by FVTRS. This handicraft training gets Anjana a significant opportunity to develop livelihood.



After getting trained for 3 months in handicraft skill training, she has become a successful entrepreneur for the local women. Anjana makes various handicrafts as ceramic art, cipra, doorbell, veneration plate, photo frame, clock and other stuffs at her home and earns Rs. 6,000 per month by selling them at local market of Ajmer or in exhibition.

It is a felling of sorrow and amaze that Anjana is a disabled since childhood. She became a victim of polio in her childhood. But it is a feeling of joy that she is full of confidence, energy and enthusiasm after all of this. It is her enthusiasm and confidence that allows her to perform so brilliantly in manufacturing handicrafts.

Now Anjana has become a source of inspiration for other localities dalit girls. Anjana tells about the handicraft education program-

A Ray of Hope

Case Study

22 years old, poor Chandni had studied till 11th, Being married at the minor age she had to leave her study. Chandni, perhaps, had a bad luck that her husband was habitual alcoholic and unemployed. He used to consume liquor and have fight with Chandni. Chandni, victim of domestic violence



kept silent due to shyness. Her marriage life was at the edge of divorce and ultimately she had to get complaint file against her husband in police station. But her in-laws were economically sound and she had to wander for justice. Her failure to get justice led her to the situation of depression.

One day she came to know about Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, she communicated and told her story to the organisation. After hearing her story, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan got her a copy of her complaint from the police station and also got her consultation from a legal advisor for divorce. In addition to, she was promoted to learn handicraft work for her livelihood. Chandni learnt handicraft training with passion and got trained successfuly. Now, Chandni makes beautiful handicraft artifacts as puja thali, photo frame, door bell, decorative wall hanging at her home and sells in the market and thus she lives a dignified live. A better livelihood from handicraft self-employment gets her able for upbringing of her 2 years old son in a better way. Chandni gets support and help from Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan in her court case of divorce.




