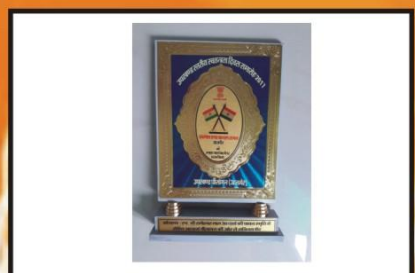

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

The Indian society has been a male dominated society since forever where women have been considered inferior to men. In such a society, women are always constrained by several social evils. Indeed a woman plays different roles in a day very easily, yet no one pays heed to her significant role she plays in the society.

In such a situation, **Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan** comes forward and raises the voice of women as being determined and committed for women empowerment, RSKS organizes and manages several programs for women upliftment in significant manner.

The programs 2017-18 that are organized by RSKS for the same are listed below :

Women Self-Help-Group

Agriculture is the mainstay of more than 75% of rural population due to which the rural community faces two major problems. Firstly, the rural community doesn't have additional source of livelihood except agriculture and secondly, insufficiency of water for irrigation and the situation becomes critical for the regions have been declared as "Dark Zone".

RSKS, as per its vision, has brought some new opportunities of employment for rural women. RSKS has developed the feeling of unity among rural women and joined them to financial and social streams. Under the program, rural women were assembled together through self-help-groups and joined them to bank.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

NABARD, GlobalGiving Foundation and ICICI Bank played significant role to financial support the project. RSKS has established more than 280 self-help-groups in distant rural areas in the current year. RSKS provided Rs. 5 crore 70 lakh micro-loan through bank to the members of the self-help-groups to establish self-employment units. Rural women started their employment units as animal husbandry, dairy, agriculture, convectionary shop, oil mill, vegetable shops, etc. with the amount of micro-loan support. In addition to this, RSKS also organizes capacity building, life skil, basic orientation, financial literacy and other programs for the women members of self-help groups, and as the impact of the efforts made by the organization capacity of rural women is developed and their life skills get improved and enhanced. The organization of such programs also developed the leadership among women that helps them to run their employment successfully.



WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Her Voice

In the 21st century, violence against women can be seen everywhere very easily. These days, we often see cases related to violence against women, whether it is an office or a public place, women become victim of indignity and molestation.

We advocates the 21st century as a modern era, but our hypothesis of the century to be modern would only be an imagination until violence against women happens. In order to bring change to the approach of the society, RSKS organized an awareness program at a large level, under which RSKS put its efforts to make the society aware of violence against women and other sensitive social issues.



Under "Her Voice", RSKS organized workshop, public awareness rally, signature campaign, my selfie program, poster competition and other programs in distant rural areas on prevention of violence against women, girl education, prevention of female foeticide, gender inequality, child marriage and other issues.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Every class and community of rural population participated in the public awareness program and supported the programs directly.

All public awareness programs organized and managed by RSKS returned positive results. Now, women has become bold enough to express themselves in the society easily that will got them their lost dignity and position in the society.

E-Shakti

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan organized E-Shakti to digitize the self-help groups managed by the organization in rural areas. Under the project rural SHGs groups were digitized with the help of digital tablets. In which all the E-details of the group are described.

E-Shakti has introduced facilitation to the functionality and management of the self-help groups along with transparency that has increased the ratings of the groups and it accelerated the evaluation/execution of loan applications in bank.



EDUCATION



However, Right to education is equal for all children without considering its class, caste or community, but we often see discrimination in its implementation. In the rural areas of Rajasthan, almost 44.6 % girls are deprived of school education as girl education has no importance in rural areas. Moreover, gender inequality in the society restricts girls to be educated.

In order to eliminate the discrimination in education and inequality, RSKS provides education to girls in different formats that promotes girl education in rural & urban slum areas.

Pathshala

In this format of education, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan provides free quality & value based education to deprived and poor girls. RSKS manages "Pathshala" in 7 distant rural areas where 210 girls get primary education free of cost.

The organization also gave free school uniform, study material to the girls so that they may come to "Pathshala" regularly and have no problem in the study. In "Pathshala", along with study sports, knowledgeable activities and cultural programs are also organized at times for the overall development of the girls.

Udan

RSKS manages "Udan" school to literate rural women. In this format of education, RSKS makes illiterate rural women learn to read and write. In "Udan", there are 25 illiterate rural women who are learning fundamental education as identifying letters & digits, addition, subtraction, etc. In addition to this, life skill and capacity building training in "Udan" makes them self-reliant and capable. "Udan" has made an educational option available to such rural women who are interested to learn.

But, in the beginning, these women faced some problems, but they followed the way of education by hard work and determination to overcome the problems and now they have become literate.



EDUCATION



Financial Literacy Program

Now-a-days, common people in the lack of information and awareness, become victim of fraud and cheat. Such incidents of fraud and cheat often happen with innocent rural people who are not aware of financial literacy. RSKS organized many awareness program to make people aware of financial issues.

In the program, the organization explained banking information to 1250 rural women & men through road shows, puppet shows, etc. and delivered message to keep their banking details confidential as these details are not to be shared. The rural community came to know about their banking rights and the ways to be safe from fraud and cheat through the program.

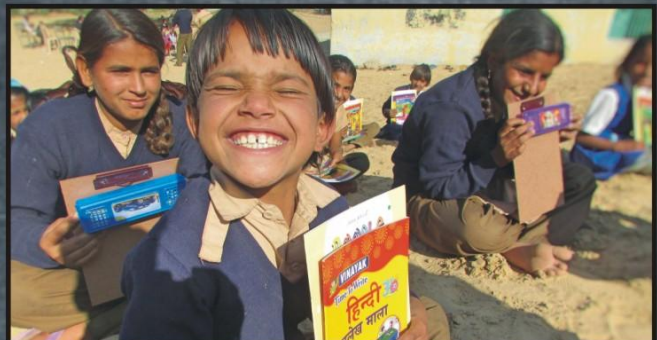


EDUCATION

EDUCATION FOR EVERY CHILD

"Education is the inherent right of every child", with this view, Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is working for the development of girl education on a large scale. RSKS is committed to achieve its aim for which we put every possible effort for the educational development of poor and deprived girls. RSKS, for the educational development of the girls, gave study material, school uniform, water bottles, woollen sweaters, caps and gloves, etc. to 4300 poor and deprived girls in the current year so that they may continue the study without facing any problem.

It is often seen that in the lack of study material, girls quit study, but the continuous efforts made by RSKS brought such girls again to the mainstream of the education. As per its commitment, RSKS gave a digital tablet to the girl who got merit on district level to motivate other girls. The digital tablet will help the girl to study easily and to learn many other knowledgeable things.



Sustainable Livelihood

Vocational Education

Today, India is considered as a young country as the youth constitutes a large part of the population. But, when we talk about employment, we find that women are getting behind in the lack of skills. RSKS organizes skill development training for skill development of women and girls through which they may be able to access the resources of sustainable livelihood.

This year, RSKS provided skill development training in different trades to more than 700 young girls/women/youth which later got them opportunity to be employed. RSKS, first identified deprived and school drop-out girls in rural and urban areas and then provided beauty parlour, bag making, handicrafts and garment making trainings to them. The skill development training of different trades got women/girls sustainable source of livelihood and made them self-reliant.

RSKS always considers the feasibility and easiness of the trainees during skill development training, for which our trainers conduct theory and practical classes both that enables the trainees to learn the skills easily.

During the training, some additional trainings as life skills, EDP, capacity building, etc. are also provided to the trainees that enhance their life skill and working capacity & efficiency. The organization also manages job fairs, exhibitions and exposure visits through which the trainees get the knowledge of market that helps them to manage self-employment unit.



Sustainable Livelihood

The skill development training has introduced some positive changes to the lives of the trainees as the beneficiaries, after completing the training, have started jobs and most of them have established self-employment units at their places. The positive change strengthens gender equality in the society as now women also have same opportunities of employment as men have in different sectors and thus, women are making their identity.

Women/youth being skilled now move out of their homes for employment and prove themselves and this helps to eradicate the social evils in the society. Now the society is changing its approach and women also have significant role in the male dominated society.

RSKS, for the authentication of the skill development training, gives certificates to the beneficiary women that help them to get better opportunities of jobs.



Environment & Sanitation

The whole is suffering from unexpected change of climate and global warming at present. As a consequence of industrial revolution the forest area has been reduced in centuries that has created the problem of increased temperature at global level and the increased temperature has adverse effect on living beings and the environment. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan has taken significant initiatives for the conservation of the environment through its projects and programs out of which some are listed below :



Adopt a Tree

Due to industrial revolution and reckless deforestation our environment is continuously diminishing and getting ahead toward the extinction gradually. Considering the situation, RSKS organizes and implements tree plantation program. Under the program, the organization planted more than 850 shady and fruitful trees



in the current year at road side, temples, government buildings, hospitals and other places. The localites and the concerning persons appreciated the efforts of RSKS and being inspired they planted trees in their surroundings on their own.

For the conservation of the environment, RSKS organized workshop in 52 different places where the importance of conservation of environment was explained to the participants and delivered message to plant more and more trees.

Save Innocent



Sparrow

Earlier it was very common to see sparrow in our surroundings but now the little innocent bird is at the verge of extinction. Due to reducing forests and industrialisation the innocent bird has lost its natural habitat that resulted in the reduction of its population.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan took an initiative for the conservation of sparrow through "Save Sparrow". Under the program, RSKS put efforts to rehabilitate sparrow by installing eco-friendly nests. This year, we installed more than 300 eco-friendly nests at different places as road side, park, temples, residential buildings, etc. In return, we had positive results of the program very soon when sparrow started laying eggs in the eco-friendly nests and rehabilitated in the nests.

CHILDREN RIGHT & WELFARE



The poor and helpless children lives in slums & street who are isolated from the mainstream of the society also constitutes a part of our society. But, the society ignores such poor and helpless children and these children have to depend on others to survive. The children being deprived of basic facilities hardly manage the meal for a day.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan brought a ray of hope to the life of such poor and helpless children through its "Make a Wish" project. The organization puts efforts to fulfill basic requirements of such children through the project. This year, we gave food, toys, new clothes, slippers, shoes, sweets, etc, to more than 700 slum children that brought some moments of happiness and joy to their lives.

RSKS also found that some of the children got addicted of doping and involved in anti-social activities. Then, RSKS met the family members of such children and consulted them through counselling. We consulted them to focus on nurturing of their little ones to get them better health and nourishment. The result of counselling with the parents is that the children now quit anti-social activities and doping and they are living a better life.

RSKS also took initiative to join such children to the mainstream of education for their educational development. We again consulted their parents and promoted them to send their children to schools and made them understand the importance of education in their life. Then, the parents started sending their children to schools for their educational development in which RSKS supported them completely.



RSKS also organized poster making competition, sports competition and other cultural programs for such poor children in which they participated with enthusiasm and enjoyed.



Health

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan also manages several projects for public health.

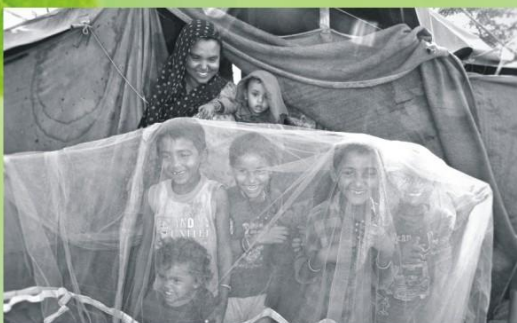
"Be Free ~ Be Happy ~ Be Smiley"

Menstruation is still one of the issues in India on which we feel uncomfortable to discuss in society. In rural regions, women still don't know how to deal with menstruation properly.

They still use old and insecured stuffs as cotton, piece of cloth, newspaper, etc. while menstruation. According to their nature, rural women ignore health disorders that makes them suffering from various diseases.

RSKS, to make the community aware of the sensitive issue, organized "Be Free ~ Be Happy~Be Smiley" program. Under the program, workshops were held in rural areas where the way to use sanitary pads and how to make menstruation safe and other health related topics were explained to the participants.

RSKS distributed more than 9500 sanitary pads so that women and girls may have safe and secured menstruation.

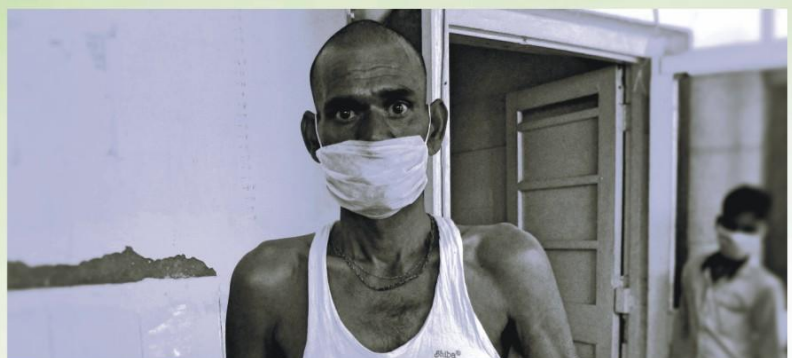


Kill Malaria

Under the program managed by RSKS, we made people aware of malaria in mosquito prone regions and distributed mosquito nets to poor families. The community was made aware of diseases spread by mosquitoes in workshops and the ways of immunity and first aid we also discussed.

T.B. MDR

Under the program, RSKS gives protein diet every month to poor patients of MDR & XDR T.B patient. The protein diet includes eggs, pulses, protein-x, protein bar, etc. that is given to the patients that helps the patients to health recover.



Health

Happiness on Wheel



Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan tried to get some moments of happiness to physically challenged persons and to provide them an opportunity of employment, tri-cycles with mobile shop were given. Being physically challenged, such people depend on others and not able to be employed. RSKS took initiative by giving them tri-cycle with which they started mobile shops.

Dabur (Good Health, Better Life)

Poor people don't get required nutritions in the food they have, due to which they are not able to maintain health and get ill very often. RSKS, to enhance immunity of such 4100 women men and children, distributed Dabur Chyavanprash so that they may have required nutrition which they don't get from food. By consuming Dabur Chyavanprash, these women got enhanced immunity and gradually recovered their health.



Health

Safe Motherhood (SUMA)



Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, in collaboration with, SUMA Chetan, organized safe motherhood program. Under the program we made the community aware of the safety of pregnant women so that mother and child both may be safe and healthy.

Disaster Recovery & Management

Barmer Flood Relief



Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan organizes the relief program to provide relief to the victims of natural disasters that occur at times. The heavy rainfall in the western Rajasthan last year caused the situation of flood that submerged a large part of Barmer district due to which people lost their homes, agriculture and livestock.

RSKS organized relief camp in Barmer to provide relief to the flood victims. The relief work was accomplished in four phases. After completing the first phase, we managed ration for food security of the victims and provided ration to 250 flood victim families immediately.

In the second phase, we distributed 500 mosquito nets to the victim families so that they might be able to protect themselves from the diseases caused by mosquitoes as water got stagnated everywhere after the flood.

In the third phase, we distributed blankets to the victim families that protected them during winters. In this phase we distributed blankets to 650 victim people and compensation was also given to them from the government relief fund. The victim families bought basic stuffs to meet day-to-day requirements from the compensation.

In the fourth and last phase, we provided employment to the victims. RSKS first identified 30 victim families and gave 2 goats to each family to start dairy. In this phase, we also rehabilitated the victims who lost their residences in the flood. We identified 10 victim families and got them house constructed. RSKS was committed to its work and its positive result was seen during flood relief camp.

Disaster Recovery & Management



Operation Humanity

The major objective of the project managed by RSKS is to provide instant relief to the needy and to remain humanity alive in the practical world. Under the program, RSKS provides ration to helpless old age women every month. In order to maintain the food security of these women we gave them flour, pulses, rice, spices, sugar, soap, fruits and vegetables, etc. in ration.

The support from RSKS to these women not only maintains their food security but also let them to live dignified live. At this age, they now have every day mean without any stress and tension. RSKS also makes them feel better at the old age by its love and affection that they most need at this phase of life. These women say that humanity still lives in the society and they have faith in humanity which RSKS proves with its continuous efforts.



In addition to this, RSKS identified an old age couple who were both physically challenged and used to depend on others to survive. RSKS did the required to provide them instant relief. RSKS provides ration to the couple also every month that maintains their food security.

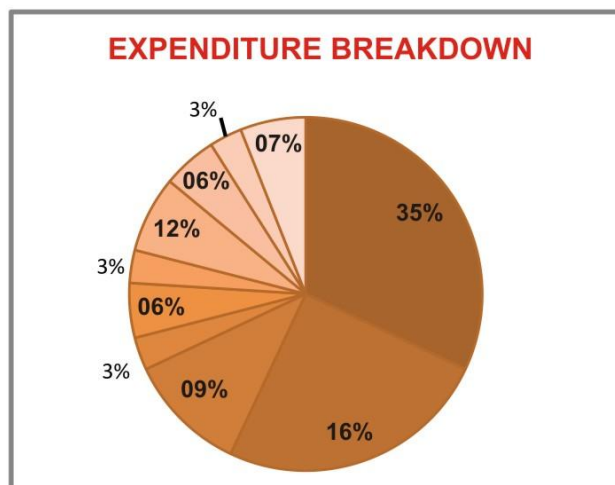

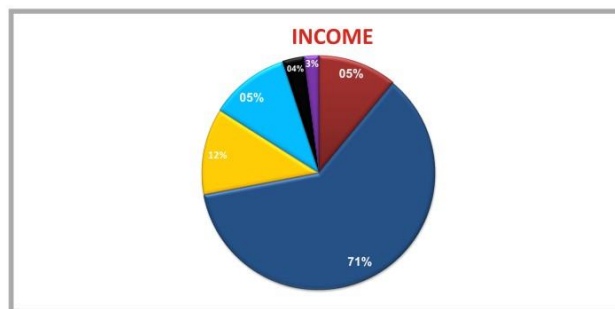
