**M**ore than 40 complaints against "violence against women", 10 rape cases registered everyday, 3 women are killed just because of dowry in every 48 hours. It is not a fiction but these are terrible facts of Rajasthan state. It is to be considered that these facts are official which get registered in various police stations of the state everyday. Hundreds of women, victims of violent persecution and outrage, don't even dare to come forward just because of family pressure, loss of shame amongst people and threat in this male dominated society and loose their identity in the darkness of anonymousness.

Similarly, due to some traditional social evils such as dowry system, purda system and child marriage which have been practicing for many years, women don't have a special status in the society.

# Sustainable livelihood

**A**s per the Government of India's report 2011, the country has 46.9 million unemployed youth of 15 - 24 years age group. Due to the unemployment, youth adopts immoral and wrong way to earn livelihood. Similarly, agriculture and stock-raising are the major sources of livelihood in rural areas but the problem of availability of water of agriculture is getting more terrible and the youth in villages doesn't have any other firm source of livelihood there.



There are some significant chances for better livelihood in non-agricultural occupations. Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, with this thought, has been managing vocational training schools successfully for the welfare of women and girls of marginalized and deprived section. They are not only getting quality training for garment making, bag making, beauty parlour, food processing, computer

education, handicraft, nurse in these training schools but also getting knowledge of life skills, market and marketing in these vocational schools so that these women may become successful entrepreneurs.



Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan has already provided skill development training to almost 11500 men and women of marginalized section since the foundation. Hundreds of these men and women are getting better livelihood by establishing self-employment and living a prosperous life.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan has its focus towards youth mainly at present because the youth is the bright future of the country and several vocational training courses are being executed successfully for the youth.

# Education

Rajasthan state has 13.20 lakh school drop-out children of 6 - 14 years age group according to the survey report 2013-14 of "Sarv Shiksha Abhiyaan" of the government of Rajasthan. It is a terrible figure of school drop-outs. Besides that the election commission has declared that one must pass minimum 8th standard for the candidacy of Panchayat elections. This declaration has increased the importance of education more. As per census 2011, the state has 67.41 literacy rate which is not so good and the rate shows illiteracy and backwardness in the state.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is working on various educational models with deprived section for the educational development and better literacy in which "Patshala" schools for school drop-out kids and brief syllabus of middle level education for women are managed in remote villages. Hundreds of women and children are getting quality education in these schools so that these children may build their career by getting educated.

## Education

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan, in addition to education camps, provides study material as pen, books, uniform, sweater, color, note book, school shoes, school fee, etc. to poor and deprived children. The organisation has made 550 women literate and besides that benefitted more than 200 children with quality education and distributed study material to 700 poor school kids for their educational development.

Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan is aimed to provided quality education to 11000 women and children for which the organisation is trying hard with dedication and determination.





## Campaign & Advocacy

**T**he rural area of Rajasthan state is surrounded by diversities. The villagers have to face hard troubles from time to time due to illiteracy, social evils, draught and the society doesn't have any strong measure for its solution. Illiteracy and lack of leadership are the main reasons for it.

A campaign to advocate the issues of interest of poor deprived section is being organised by Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan. This campaign includes various issues as child sex-ratio, safe motherhood, uprooting of violence against women, right to education and information and legal rights of women. The deprived section is getting aware of their legal rights by this program.

Nothing Worth Having Comes Easy

**M**anju devi resides at village Rajgarh is a poor woman and belongs to Dalit community. She is 34 years old and studied up to 9th standard. The financial conditions of her family didn't allow her to study further. Manju devi is a handicapped which is a bone in her life. As her both the legs were disabled since the childhood she had faced so many difficulties in her life. Lt. Ugam Chand, husband of Manju had died after 11 years of their marriage and thus she was deeply burdened under the heap of sorrow. Now she had the responsibility of her two boys and she found herself unable even to do labor as she was maimed. Her family was in deep trouble.



One day she had to meet with one of the activists of Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan who informs her about designer bag education training being executed in the collaboration of Rajasthan Samgrah Kalyan Sansthan. She immediately got herself registered for the training. Although she is handicapped, she has learnt the art of making almost every sort of bag with dedication in the training. Now she is very much skilled in the art of bag making and earns Rs. 300/- a day by making cloth and jute bags with hand-held sewing machine. She sews new designer bags every day and sells them to local women and thus she is earning to meet her family's basic requirements.

Manju devi has now got a sustainable mean of earning in which she does hardworking. Now her life has become progressed and she is able to nurture her two boys. She often sells her designer bags in the fairs held in the village which gets her a good profit. Despite of being disabled she has gained success and has set a perfect example in the society and thus she has become an inspiration for such other women.

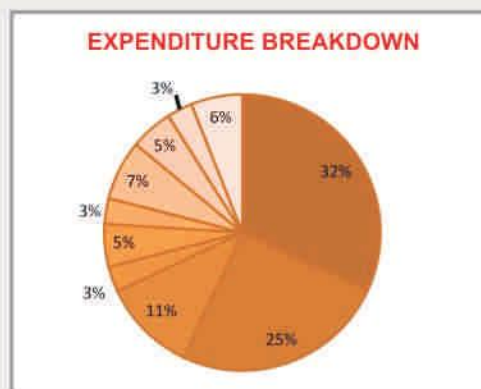

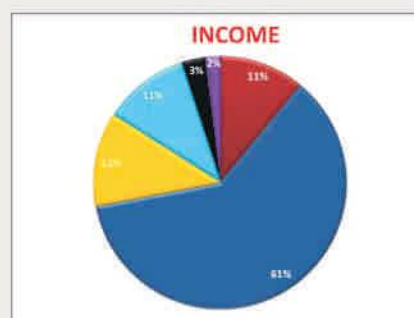
