




Licensed Ophthalmologists Needed For 2016 Volunteer Cataract Mission to Myanmar



Join our next cataract mission to Myanmar (formerly Burma) to perform life changing cataract surgeries using Extracapsular Cataract Extraction (ECCE) and Small Incision Cataract Surgery (SICS) procedures.

This is a call for current, licensed Ophthalmologists to Global Community Service Foundation in September 2015 as we launch our next volunteer cataract mission to Myanmar to perform dozens of life changing cataract surgeries. This week long mission will give participating surgeons the chance to interact with the local ophthalmologists who will follow up with the cases after the team leaves. This is your opportunity to give back to people who would otherwise not have access to these simple yet important surgeries.



When: September 17 - 24, 2016
(In Myanmar Mission Dates)

Where: Hsipaw, Myanmar is in Shan State located in a valley on the riverbank of Duthawadi River. It is 200 km (124 mi) northeast of Mandalay.

Important information

Cost of the mission is \$1,500 plus international airfare to Yangon. Cost will cover visa, all in-country transportation, lodging, food and activities and medical evacuation insurance. Surgeons are required to bring their own instruments. The mission trip is tax deductible.
