For example, the growth in the number of homeless people in Brazilian cities isn't an issue that city halls can solve alone.

Basic social assistance, housing, health, and employment are some aspects of the complexity of a project removing people from the streets, or homeless people. This requires collaboration of the three sectors - government, companies and social organizations-, working together in a complementary way.
