9.0 TARGET BENEFICIARIES:

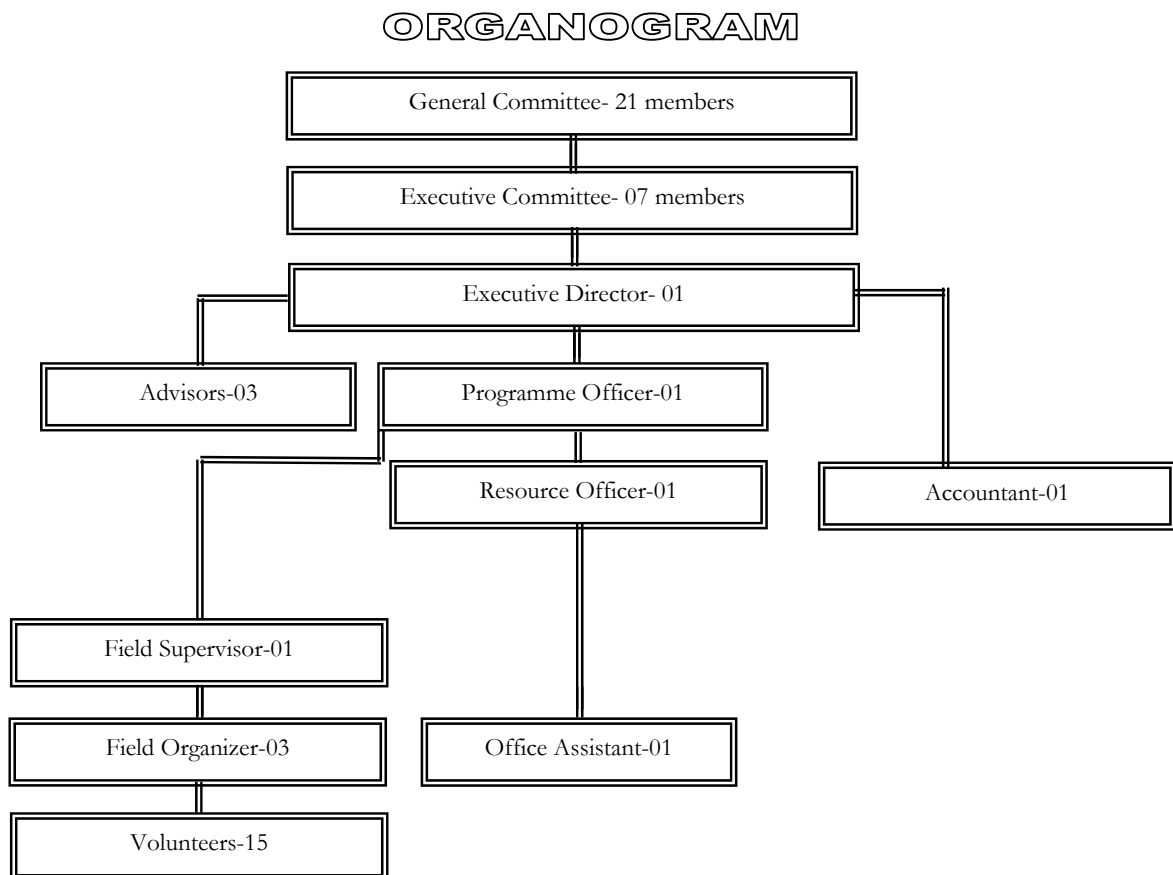

12.0 PROJECTS' INFORMATION IN BRIEF:

CAD, an implementing organization, has been directly reaching its supports and services to its target beneficiaries at the grass-root level through a number of projects and programs for the improvement of the overall socio-economic situation of the target peoples. The following activities are being done:

AWARENESS RAISING AND RIGHT ESTABLISHMENT PROJECT

WOMEN RIGHT AWARENESS PROGRAM:

The targeted women are organized into small group and CAD reaches to them through development supports and services. The women are educated on Reproductive health, child health, family planning, and human rights issue, etc. in a weekly meeting and discussion at home yard of a beneficiary.

AID MATERIAL SUPPORT FOR POOR DISABLED STUDENTS:

To widen assistance for the Poor Disabled Students so that they might get relieved of difficulties due to lack **Aid Material**. CAD has been taken in its concern to do something for the disabled children. This is why; CAD has been implementing the project with a view assisting the disabled students of aged 7-15 in **03** Union of Skaikkupa Upazila in Jhenidah District, the south-west part of Bangladesh. The project is running with financial assistance of the Aaron D. Sasson Charitable Trust, London-UK.

SUPPLY STUDY MATERIAL AND WARM CLOTH FOR HANDICAPPED CHILDREN:

CAD has taken this project with the financial assistance HOPE for Children-UK with a view to assisting 50 disabled children by providing study material like khata, school bag, pen and pencil, arithmetic boxes and warm cloths of aged 7-15 in **02** Union of Jhenaidah Sadar Upazila in Jhenidah District, the south-west part of Bangladesh..

REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH RIGHT PROMOTION PROJECT:

The project is designed in keeping with concept of '**Sound Reproductive Health and Safe Motherhood**' that is one of the basic emphasis of CAD at community level. The

theme emphasizes on the need of reducing the violation of the reproductive health rights among rural adolescent girls. To achieve the aim of this project different activities are carrying out with view to creating favorable atmosphere for enjoying reproductive health rights and reduce the number of early marriage and mothers' mortality rate due to forced pregnancy at the immature age.

GOOD GOVERNANCE AND RIGHT EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

This is a networking project with **03** NGOs. **60** elected women members of **20** Union Councils are educated on good governance and its impacts on the society. **05** Dispute Resolution Committee in each union is formed and this committee has been playing and effective rule to control over the social security of the women. **1200** women are educated on their basic right of education, health and democracy.

ANIMATORS' TRAINING AND SKILL TRAINING FOR THE YOUTH

Recently, CAD has extended its cooperation among the youth with assistance of 'The Hunger Project-Bangladesh' under the above-mentioned project. In the mean time, an animators' training has been arranged in Padmakar Union of Jhnaidh Sadar Upazila. **120** participants were present in the meeting. They are now getting trade-wise skill training under the guidance the Hunger Project-Bangladesh.

INCOME GENERATION ACTIVITIES:

COMMUNITY FISHING PROGRAM:

This program is continuing from 2005. Under the program CAD has invested capital to villagers' group and they cultivate fish in their own ponds and watery lands. The beneficiaries are given training on fishing in pond, preparation of fish feed, nursing and care fishlings, etc. The ownership of the profit is 60:40 (Beneficiary: CAD).

CAD NURSERY PROJECT:

CAD has own nursery on the contracted land. CAD grows plants of indigenous fruit plants, flower and other wooden trees here. The profit from this selling is another income for CAD annually.

MICRO-CREDIT SUPPORT PROGRAM FOR RURAL WOMEN:

The group members are provided credit supports for undertaking and operating income-generating activities. The main aim of the credit program is to help the poorest of the poor group members for alleviating their acute poverty. The group members are provided necessary technical supports for their IGAs projects on poultry rising, livestock fattening, Nursery, Grocers Shops, fish cultivation activities, Vegetable Marketing and Seed Production.
