YCM has 110 young people aged between 9 and 23 years (most are 10 to 14 years) undertake its program and believes in peer tutoring, mentoring and coaching rather than a teacher-student approach to learning.

The participants are learning basic English, general knowledge, character building (basic), and computer.
- b. Aged 15 -- 23 year old (practical learning program)
