## Services

1. Lunch delivered to senior citizens during weekends.
2. Housekeeper service for our elderly participants.
3. Participants without transportation are taken to their medical appointments, grocery stores and/or to the pharmacy.
4. Health care programs for elderly individuals suffering from different health conditions. This program is managed by a registered nurse.
5. Vocational courses (pastry) to unemployed people so they can develop skills to create their own business or to get a related job that will help them to make a difference in their families by being self-sustaining.
6. Health Fair for the community.
7. Emergency help to families and individuals (groceries, clothes and others).
