2. PROJECT INFORMATION**Introduction:**

In our project scope numbers of orphan and street children are found. The problem of orphan and street children is that they are deprived from the fundamental social, educational and human rights. The reason of deprivation of these children is long-running wars that still drag Afghanistan. Due to wars these children lose their parents and guardians thus these children are left without care and support. These children are involved in rag picking; pick pocketing and participating in anti-social, drug addiction and criminal activities. Therefore we envisage mainstreaming these children the national building by providing schooling needs, computer training, uniforms, nutrition and books and life skills to lead them to a better future.

Our Mission:

Mainstreaming the Orphan and Street children in the national building by providing care, support & protection through medicine, schooling needs, food, and education is our mission.

The Project – An Overview:

In spite of planned development and special provision for accelerated socio-economic development of vulnerable sections, the issue of orphan and street children is not properly addressed. In our project scope many Orphan and Street Children are found. The problem of orphan and street children is long-running was that still drag Afghanistan. Due to wars these children lose their parents and guardians, therefore they have no proper upbringing and financial support thus these children are put at immediate risk because they have no upbringing and financial support being in orphaned status, they are often seen as burden on relatives. Children living in this situation are in danger of losing opportunities for school, health care, development and nutrition. These children are involved in rag picking& participating in anti-social, criminal activities

These children are involved in rag picking; pick pocketing and participating in anti-social, criminal activities. Therefore, we attempt for mainstreaming these children in the national building by providing care and support.

Summary

This project is aiming to help 50 orphan and street children to starting going to school in Kunar, Afghanistan. These children will be given computer training, nutritious food, uniforms, medicine, schooling need, extra-curricular activities, and career guidance to strengthen their dreams and become useful citizen of Afghanistan. The goal of the project is to make **“today’s deprived into tomorrow compassionate helper”** we plan to reach 500 ages between 7 -18 years through this project

What is the issue, problem, or challenge?

There are millions of orphan & street children in Afghanistan who lost their parents due to long-running wars. Orphan& street children are put at immediate risk because they have no upbringing & financial support being in orphaned status, they are often seen as burden on relatives. Children living in this situation are in danger of losing opportunities for school, health care, development & nutrition. These children are involved in rag picking& participating in anti-social, criminal activities

How will this project solve this problem?

We have identified orphan & street children who are vulnerable and deprived. By identifying the needs of each child accordingly we provide counseling and mentoring as well as nutritious food, 2 set of uniforms, schooling needs, quality education, extra-curricular activities with life skills training that make them useful citizens and sympathetic helper for the same children of tomorrow.

Potential Long Term Impact

The project will build the lives of 500 orphans and destitute children, making them the productive citizens of tomorrow so that they can contribute to their family, society and

country. Over the 2 years, our organization will be touching the lives of hundreds more children by providing them the protective shelter, parental care, and opportunities to harness their talents and dreams.

Project Message

Project Objectives:

- To provide orphan and street children, a childhood that they never experienced and help them to become useful members of the society.
- To encourage orphan and street children to kindle their potential by providing creative opportunities
- To make available opportunities where orphan and street children can play and enjoy their childhood.
- To provide basic education to orphan and street children in nearby schools.
- To provide basic literacy and facilities for those who wish to study further
- To select and prepare for computer skills in order to live on their own legs
- To accomplishing physical, intellectual and aesthetic development of the child

Project Activities:

- Identification of orphan and street children
- Pre-view of the incoming orphan and street children problem/difficulties Emotional acceptance of the child to let them to helped from this project
- Providing facilities for basic education in nearby schools
- Teaching facilities for computer training courses
- Recreational facilities
- Primary health.

Methodology:

We have been identifying orphan and street children through our volunteers, citizens, police department, women and child welfare department. We Pre-view of the incoming orphan and street child problems. We counsel and arrange for sympathetic acceptance of the orphan and street child. We are planning to implement this particular project in Kunar province, Afghanistan where numbers of orphan and street children are already identified. We arranged teaching facilities in nearby schools according to their age. We also provide home tuitions, medicine, recreation and health care.

We will mobilize both cash and kind. We have limited resources to implement this project of helping 50 orphan and street children. Orphan and street children are in severe need. We need support from the donors and philanthropists to meet the needs planned for

orphan and street children through organization. We seek support for about 2 years. Meanwhile, we will sustain to mobilize continuous local donations through exhibiting our good work and service. We are planning to further extend our services to reach 500 children by acquiring donations from donors and philanthropists.

We will arrange permanent project staff to take care of children who besides handling day-to-day administration and will look after children. One computer trainer will be hired. A doctor will be appointed as Center Medical Attendant on honorarium and all the inmates will be provided with health check-up, medicines, food, one set of books and two sets of uniform every year.

The proposal covers 50 orphans and street children. Every child will be provided with nutritional diet, recreation and play facilities and hobbies.

Impact analysis:

The project will be monitored at regular intervals through a “Project Monitoring Committee (PMC)” constituted with the Director of the organization, Authorities from the Funding Agency, Local District Administration etc., will be nominated as members to the project Monitoring committee. This committee would meet periodically once in 2 months and taking M&E activities and advise on various aspects concerning implementation of project and review of the programs/activities undertaken. The Project Monitoring Committee will also review the accounts and audited statements.
