- To consider challenges faced by vulnerable women and those living and affected with HIV, implement projects that would create an environment that does not restrain their potential.
- ➤ Train the women to start small scale projects, then teach them how to move to bigger enterprises.
- ➤ To educate the community through engaging vulnerable women and those living and affected with HIV to start small income generating projects together, so that the community will embrace vulnerable women and those living and affected with HIV. Thus increasing their confidence, social interaction and inclusion.
- ➤ Introduce projects that are short term so that they quickly realize profits to earn a living e.g. poultry and hoticulture projects.
- > Provide project inputs as loans.
- > Constant training and monitoring on all our projects.
- > Assist the women with sourcing out market for their produce.
- > Funding will continue to be a REVOLVING FUND so that we will be able to assist more women who are vulnerable and those living and affected with HIV.
- ➤ The profits will be used to improve the women's livelihoods, their children, extended family members, as well as providing for their basic needs of life.



## Desired end result/ Overall objectives of the project

- -To see women beneficiaries being able to run projects by themselves through sustainable funded projects.
- -To see women who are vulnerable and those living and affected with HIV having equal opportunities with their counterparts and their children receiving the same treatment with the others in the society.
