The earthquake took away more than the physical structures from the community, it also impacted peoples esteem. Over the last months when puppeteers or theater groups visit us we recognize the importance and impact of creativity in face of devastation. Our current library is housed in a tiny temporary bamboo structure where kids come flocking in every afternoon. Many donated books sit unused, stacked in boxes that are difficult to reach in the cramped space. When frequent downpours occur during this rainy season, our books are threatened by water and mud because our roof is just plastic lining. The future Community Center will house the library, teacher training space, arts and crafts workshops, theater, capoeira, yoga studio, community meeting space and a small volunteer suite.
