Genesis of SPARSH:

On the 30th of September 1993, a devastating earthquake hit 83 villages in the district of Latur and Osmanabad. The lack of medical facilities in the region resulted in the loss of many lives as an aftermath of the earthquake. In the wake of this tragedy, P.R.I.D.E. India set up the Sastur project of Action Research Services (SPARSH). This was done through rural hospital and community health care service centre set up in collaboration with the Government of Maharashtra in 1996.

FOCUS AREAS OF SPARSH



Primary Healthcare Services

- · Out patient care (OPD) with well-equipped examination, consultation and specialist support
- Diagnostic facilities like xray, ultra sonography and pathological laboratory test.
- · Pharmacy with all essential & vital medicines
- · Round the clock **Ambulance services**

- · Maternity ward and well equipped labour/ delivery room
- · Care during all stages prenatal, antenatal, intranatal, postnatal
- Intensive neonatal care unit
- 24*7 ambulance service for expectant mothers

Support and Care of people living with HIV AIDS (PLHIV)

- Community Care Centre (CCC): 5 - bedded facility inside the hospital exclusively for HIV positive patients.
- Anti Retro-Viral Therapy (ART) centre at the hospital
- Vihaan Care and Support Centre (CSC): Provides a safe space for PLHIV, social linkages and follow up for ART adherence
- · Comprehensive support for orphaned children affected with HIV


