Mold Remediation

In the aftermath of Superstorm Sandy, many residents of New Jersey were in great need of volunteer assistance to restore their homes in the months following Sandy. To further impede their recovery efforts, many homes that sustained damage had become infested with mold. As the dangers of living with or around mold are significant, Hearts & Hands Disaster Recovery was founded. With the mold remediation program, HHDR provides professionally trained and certified volunteers to conduct free mold remediation to homeowners to assist them with their recovery efforts.

Charlie's House

Charlie's House utilizes a contemporary model of Buckminster Fuller's geodesic dome that was used in deploying Marines to the Middle East during World War II; a modern design now adapted for temporary housing. HHDR is currently accepting referrals for the use of this structure beginning in October 2015.

Operation Headed Home

In an effort to provide residents in need of rebuilding, repairing, and/or elevating their homes HHDR has launched its latest program to further assist residents with their unmet needs. HHDR may utilize RREM Grant award funds to assist residents through the completion of their home repair or new home construction project. Full Case Management services are provided if needed. This program is currently available throughout New Jersey.
