We note that 30% was budgeted to be allocated to the Scholarship Fund, which represents £277.02 of the total funds received from Global Giving. The amount of £75.24, or 8.1% of the total funds received, has been registered. We would like to mention that the budget for the Scholarship Fund has a positive balance of £201.78.

We note that the Passive Fund includes items which support the Adult Education Project and the Scholarship Fund. We underline that the amount of £302.73 exceeds the budget of £277.02 or 30% of the total funds received from Global Giving by £25.71.

As a result, a total positive balance of £132.93 is recorded. Since the total positive balance is derived from the Scholarship Fund, we intend to utilize it as a part of the Scholarship Fund or the Adult Education Project respectively.
