Sponsorship

Sponsorship costs US \$ 35 / Euro 25 a month. You receive pictures and sixmonthly progress reports of a particular child. The support is given to the sponsored child, the family and the local community – and is used on:

Education

More children in India are joining school than before. Still, only 15% are completing secondary school. Fewer girls than boys are joining school – and more are dropping out of school before having completed 10 years of education.



The sponsorship amount is used on school equipment, school fees, coaching classes, better infrastructure and increased educational quality.

Health and nutrition

Health and poverty are interlinked. Good health is a human right, but far from a reality in India. More than 1/3 of the world's undernourished children are living in India, and 20% of children under the age of five suffers from acute malnourishment.

The sponsorship amount is used, among other things, to awareness work, yearly health check-ups, nutritional support and medical aid according to need.

Family development

All family members are enabled to help themselves out of poverty – and hence, not depend on aid. *The sponsorship amount is used, among other things, to voccational training, start of small scale businesses as well as other family support according to need.*



Community development

The whole local community is involved in the devlopment process. We are particularly concerned about women, dalits (untouchables) and participation of other marginalized groups.

Individuals and groups with abilty to make changes within their environments are focal ones.

The sponsorship amount is being used to support youth groups and self help groups for women.
