Who Are We?

Orphans' Future was founded in 2005 and was registered on February 15, 2006 as a non-profit, non-government charitable foundation that supports orphans in the Ternopil region, Ukraine. The Board of the Foundation consists of former pupils of the Koropets orphanage and highly educated orphan graduates who have experienced firsthand the everyday problems faced by youth deprived of parental care.

What Do We Want?

- · To improve orphans' lives through providing opportunities to every individual
- To prevent the problems orphans face after graduation: crime, suicide and prostitution
- To help orphans become responsible, confident, self sufficient and active members of their society
- To assist orphans to get a quality education and an appropriate job relating to their skills
- \cdot To help orphans find a place to live and build their lives
- \cdot To encourage orphans to give back to others in need



What Do We Do?

We run fundraising campaigns to fund our activities and programs such as:


- · The humanitarian program "Heart to Heart" involves students around the world who share clothes, toys, school supplies and sports equipment with the orphans during the holidays such as Christmas, Easter and Children's Day (June 1st). The program also provides Pen Pals for the orphans.
- · "The Graduate" program provides career-oriented training and basic household goods to orphan teenagers and the graduates. It covers internship expenses for well educated orphans. It also assists the graduates affected by poverty and homelessness with finding shelter, jobs and developing skills.
- The Foster Care program promotes the national family care system in the Ternopil region by assisting local families with training.
- · The Summer Skills Camp program involves volunteers teaching orphans needed life skills: crafts, languages, communication, time and money management, etc.

- · Orphans' Future works with medical organizations to provide basic health care products for the orphans including eyeglasses, hygienic items and medicines.
- The Foundation supports local NGOs' initiatives, that work with orphans, such as: Brotherhood of Orphans, Orphans of Ternopil, etc.

Our long-term projects:

To build or reconstruct a building which provides temporary shelter for 10-15 homeless orphan graduates each year. The building will have a resource center which will include a library, a computer with access to the internet and printer, and other services for *all* orphans of the Ternopil region.

To continue to assist families who wish to adopt or become foster parents of the children from orphanages of the Ternopil region.
