**Help learners find their
purpose in South Africa**

Project Summary

Our initiative is to help learners from a small mine villages in South Africa discover their true self and purpose in life by providing a privately initiated programme that will be custom made for each pupil. Helping them gain skills for the management of their talents and how they can make an income from it to reduce the dependence on an employer and create a sustainable and independent society which is economically free through God given talents.

One of the more important characteristics of the education system lies in its linkages with the socio-economic structure. The program will not be based on IQ levels as it aims to expose an individuals true talent.

Requested Funding Amount

Underlying assumptions

\$20 000 is needed for the project

- The X overs will have an annual growth rate of 0.9%.

Points to ponder: there are numerous methods to measure the economic growth of a country (GDP). The real GDP is the total value of goods and services that are produced in the economy in a certain time period with the term "real" indicating that the GDP has been adjusted to remove the effects of inflation.

- The organisation requires \$20 000 of funding in order to develop the project.

Sensitivity analysis

- In the event of an economic downturn, the NGO will not see a major decline in revenues . Education programs focused are in demand regardless of the general economic climate as they are an essential service.

Requested Funding Amount

- \$20 It will provide meals for pupils per programme session
- \$80 To provide 1 module out of 8 for 30 pupils
- \$120 To provide 1 pupil a custom made curriculum for 3 years

What is the issue, problem or challenge?

- The problem that we are trying to solve as an organisation is ending the cycle of poverty through education, career development, entrepreneurship development & support, access to jobs, networking opportunities, access to continental and global markets, and financial literacy.
- The problem is dependence of people on the mining company for employment and as the only source of income in a small mine village called Vaal Reefs, North West Province in South Africa. The company in mining now has been closing off a number of their operations due to the exhaustion of the minerals being mined. In the past years the Company has closed down 9 of 11 operations that left employees without jobs and homeless that affected the economy of the villages around and towns. Now the company having only 2 operations that are still producing.

How will this solve the problem?

- Discovery of an individual's natural talent or original purpose and knowing how to manage it and make an income from it will reduce the dependence on a company for employment. It will redirect young people flocking to a certain area for employment and turn them into employers and creating further job opportunities and exploring the rest of the country. We are more of turning the thing around taking out the mentality of being an employee, rather be an employer creating opportunities.

Potential Long-Term Impact

- Developed and empowered leaders who have had an opportunity to discover their naturally given talent or purpose and have developed a skill of managing that talent and making an income from it. Not depending solely on an employer and being able to empower and inspire others to do the same.
