The mission of the Primary Education Project is to provide sustainable, quality education, especially for girls, without disgimination, in un-reached marginalized communities, developing the skills of teachers and creating a network of effective leaders through wide - ranging training programs.



The Primary Education Project (PEP) is a part of the education work of Diocese of Hyderabad. And has supported 77 communities in four districts of rural Sindhto open a school in their village.

Our Schools A trained teacher from the community provides multi- grade teaching using interactive learning resources that encourage a positive educational environment for students.









Initial Teacher Educational Programme (ITEP)

The ITEP is an important part of the project and focuses on developing the skills of teachers to teach students effectively in the classroom and become change agents for their communities.
