### Our Mission

We empower Ghanaian children to thrive through education, healthcare and hope.

The Anidaso Nsae Foundation (TANF), meaning Hope Has Not Ended, was founded in 2012 by Rev Laud Kwaku Akuffo and is based in Accra, Ghana (West Africa). We are making a difference by providing underprivileged children with free education and healthcare.

We believe easy access to education and healthcare is a human right for every child. TANF seeks to help local children break away from their current impoverished environment, freeing them from child labour by offering them quality education and supporting them in pursuing a fulfilling career that provide a good standard of living.

TANF partners with a number of schools, medical centers, volunteers and sponsors to address the key challenges: poverty, child labour being prioritized by families over education, and insufficient access to healthcare education, screening and medication.

## Growth

We'd love for you to join the TANF family and help us reach more children by realising our vision. We're very proud of the impact we've made to date, but we're very ambitious and are starting a new phase in our organisation with lot's of exciting plans currently underway.

Our sponsorship goal is to sponsor 10,000 children through primary and secondary school by 2022. We're serious about achieving this and have recently started 2 important infrastructure projects that will act as catalysts in increasing our impact. We're building a new HQ and volunteer house to reduce our overheads and triple our volunteer capacity. And, we're funding the construction of a 3 story school that will be home to 450 children every year. This is the first of 4 TANF built schools in Accra before we continue our work in the remaining 9 regions of Ghana.

Child sponsorship is an important part of our strategy and we'd love you to join us on this incredible journey and truly change the life of a Ghanaian child.

# Your Impact

Survival and a basic education isn't enough. We have bigger aspirations and believe that all children should have the opportunity to thrive. We see our kids as the next generation of entrepreneurs, doctors, politicians, and teachers, working on the biggest challenges in Ghana and beyond. Here's how together we can help.

In addition to providing a quality education we provide a safe and supportive environment, and comprehensive healthcare. We give the child the hope and encouragement to aspire to achieve their own dreams. The child becomes part of the TANF community, accessing unconditional support, love and care. # Share the Journey

We want you to feel a part of your sponsored child's journey and value your relationship with the child. When you become a TANF Child Sponsor we will help you to get to know the child, and encourage communication. There are many ways that you can be involved and kept up to date.

## **Child Introduction Pack**

You will receive information about the child's name, age, hobbies, family situation and a brief history about his/her life-path, including pictures.

## **Quarterly Update**

Every quarter we will update you on how the child is doing, their progress at school, and any events he/she attended thanks to your sponsorship.

## **Write a Letter**

You are invited to write to your sponsored child and develop a relationship. Christmas and birthday wishes are also welcome. If the sponsored child does not currently speak English, and they will soon thanks to your sponsorship, one of our team members will translate the letter and write a response from the child. Please find our address on page 6.

## **Visit Ghana!**

You even have the opportunity to come to Ghana and visit your sponsored child. We realise that this is quite a commitment but it's incredibly rewarding to see your child in their environment and to experience Ghanaian culture for yourself. Please contact the TANF team at least three months before you make any travel arrangements to discuss and agree on visiting your sponsored child in Ghana. We'd love to have you here!

## **Sorry, but No Gifts**

We don't recommend that sponsors send gifts as many sponsored children live in shared housing; we don't want other kids to feel unequal, neglected or getting less attention and care. If you really want to contribute even more (go you!), please use our Flexi Sponsor option on Global Giving to donate and specify where the money should go e.g. on children toys, food or clothing.

# Flexible Payment Plans

TANF gives you flexibility with your sponsorship payment. Fill in our online Sponsor a Child registration form, receiving a unique sponsor number and start sponsoring a child immediately.

You can choose to make a one-off payment, covering the total amount of 360USD in one transaction, or monthly payments of 30USD.
