## About us

Le Tonlé Tourism Training Center is a not-for-profit organisation providing vocational training to disadvantaged young people from Cambodia's northeastern provinces.

Le Tonlé was founded by Tourism for Help in 2007 in Stung Treng. In 2012 CRDT took over the project, funded by the Fédération Génévoise de Coopération. Le Tonlé also built a stable partnership with the Ministry of Tourism.

Since its inception, **121 students** (**63 girls**) have graduated from Le Tonlé training program.

# Our Program

Our training model is **Learning by Doing**, and our 3 month training course covers a range of industry-specific subjects.

#### THEORETICAL CLASSES

General English, English for Tourism, Administration & Invoicing, Computer Literacy, Service Excellence, and Ecology

#### PRACTICAL CLASSES

Hygiene, First Aid, House-keeping, Cooking and Food Preparation, Food & Beverage service, Front Office & Reception, and Job Application & CV Development
