Key thematic sectors of operations:-

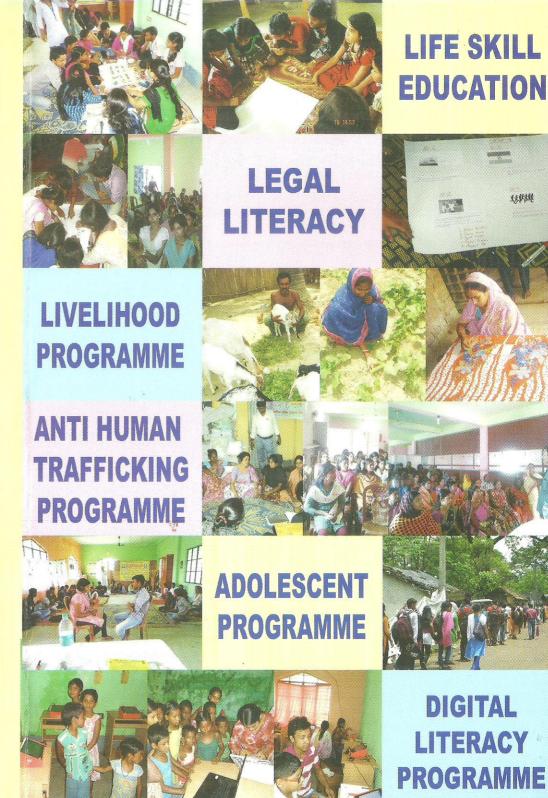
- Rights of the children including life skill development of adolescent girls'.

- Skill development for the poor and marginalized population.

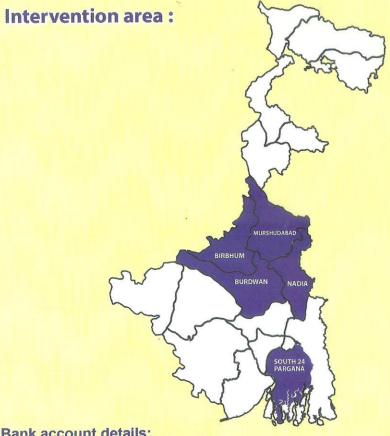
