

WHAT WE DO

HOME VISITS: This is our Child Protection Pillar. Every child enrolled in the community program is assigned to a volunteer who visits on a regular basis. Home visits emphasizes to the community the long-term value of education, good health and nutrition

LIFE SKILLS EDUCATION: Youth and children are having difficulties in making the right choices regarding their sexual reproductive health and rights, financial literacy and general life skills to say no to alcohol and unsafe sex. We implement peer-to-peer tutoring.

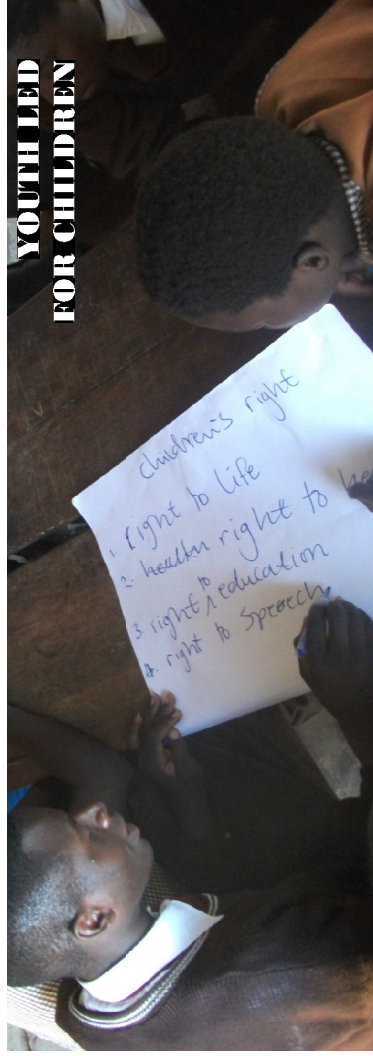
EARLY LEARNING COMMUNITY SCHOOL PROGRAM: There are no schools or centres for children (5 – 7) in the communities we work in. Children enter early grades without preparation and they lack the drive to succeed and often drop out of school because of negative peer pressure.

YOUTH RESOURCE CENTRE: providing child friendly space safe from drugs and alcohol or violence for activity, recreation, study groups and games. The centre teaches HIV prevention and good health.

RUN A BUSINESS (RAB): An initiative that will train youth and children in business and entrepreneurship to help prepare them for future jobs and own income
