Academics

Staff and Curriculum Development

- Two of our 2025 grade 7 learners were awarded high school scholarships: Iviwe to the Oprah Winfrey Leadership Academy; and Minentle to GetAhead College in Queenstown. In addition, Ukho, another Grade 7 learner, was accepted into Gonubie High School on the basis of his excellent year-end marks, and was placed 8th in grade at the end of Term 1 2026.
- Two 2026 Grade 7 learners fought off over 5 000 other applicants to reach the interview stage for an Allan Gray High School Scholarship for 2027. With only 90 candidates interviewed nationally for the 40 scholarship places, we are waiting to hear the outcomes with bated breath.
- Conquesta South African benchmarking test results:
 - Eight Grade 3 learners achieved over 80%,
 - Four Grade 2 learners and ten Grade 1 learners achieved over 80% in Maths AND English
- Two new teachers joined the team: Idah (Grade 3) and Tshepo (Grade 4)
- Volunteer specialist Jill is providing daily academic and developmental support for a learner recently identified as hard of hearing, with a diagnosed learning difficulty.
- Mathematics teaching and learning are being improved through the adoption of the White Rose Education Programme, supporting step-by-step conceptual mastery and ability to calculate.



Expanding Horizons

Enrichment and Extra Curricular Activities

- Nine boxes of contemporary, new, children's books were donated to expand the school library. The books were transported to the school by Value Logistics, our transport partner.
- The Grade 7 Service Team was launched to support leadership development of those grade 7 learners NOT chosen to be Leaders. Each service team member has a diary where they record their service activities and report back to the school leadership on a weekly basis.
- We have introduced Debating as an extra-curricular activity. Our new Senior and Junior debating teams competed for the first time in February and won two of their debates. One learner won 'Best Speaker' in two rounds.
- We are always delighted to see people volunteer their skills and time at African Angels. This quarter, we had volunteers from Australia who taught knot tying after school and taught the grade 7's to play Monopoly as part of their EMS curriculum.



Financial Support

Donations and fundraising

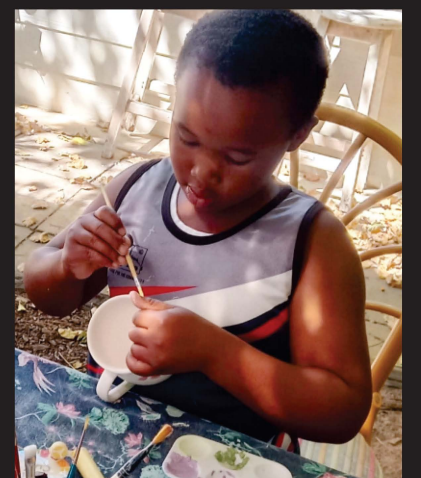
- Since 2017, African Angels has received support from The Lunch Box Fund in the form of dry groceries, which has reduced the cost of food by hundreds of thousands of Rands, as we provide daily meals to all learners.
- Ninety of the 149 African Angels who are most in need have individual sponsors contributing towards their school fees.
- Woolworths MyDifference supporters encouraged to select African Angels as their chosen cause raised R2 270.94 in Q1 2026.
- The annual African Angels Beach Walk was held 28 February and though not directly a large fundraising initiative, it does raise awareness of our school within the local community and surrounds.
- Successful Valentine's Day whole-school celebration and activities to raise funds for the Grade 7 end of year Farewell Dinner. The Grade 7 entrepreneurship initiative generated nearly R2000 in profit through Valentine's Day sales.

Support and Development

- 16 high mast solar spotlights were installed for the Chintsa East township sports field, in collaboration with long-term sponsor Beka-Schreder, to promote sports development, and a healthy lifestyle.
- Wifi was provided free and uncapped for over 3 500 local Chintsa residents living in Chintsa East Village through Q1 this year.
- The Chaba Grassroots Youth Development funded a new playground for Ikhwezilomso Educare in Chintsa East, and the Grade R class at African Angels. All were completed in Q1.
