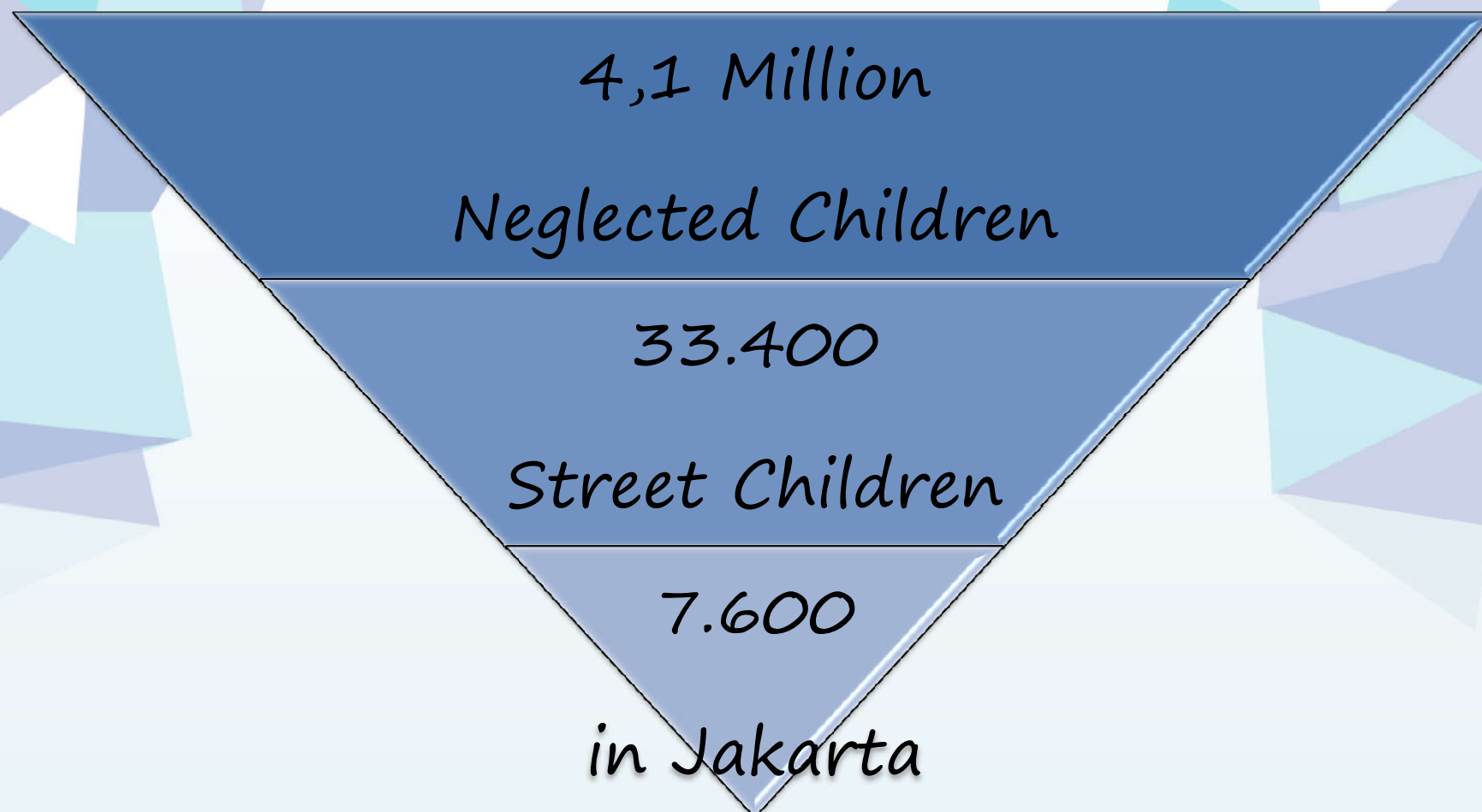

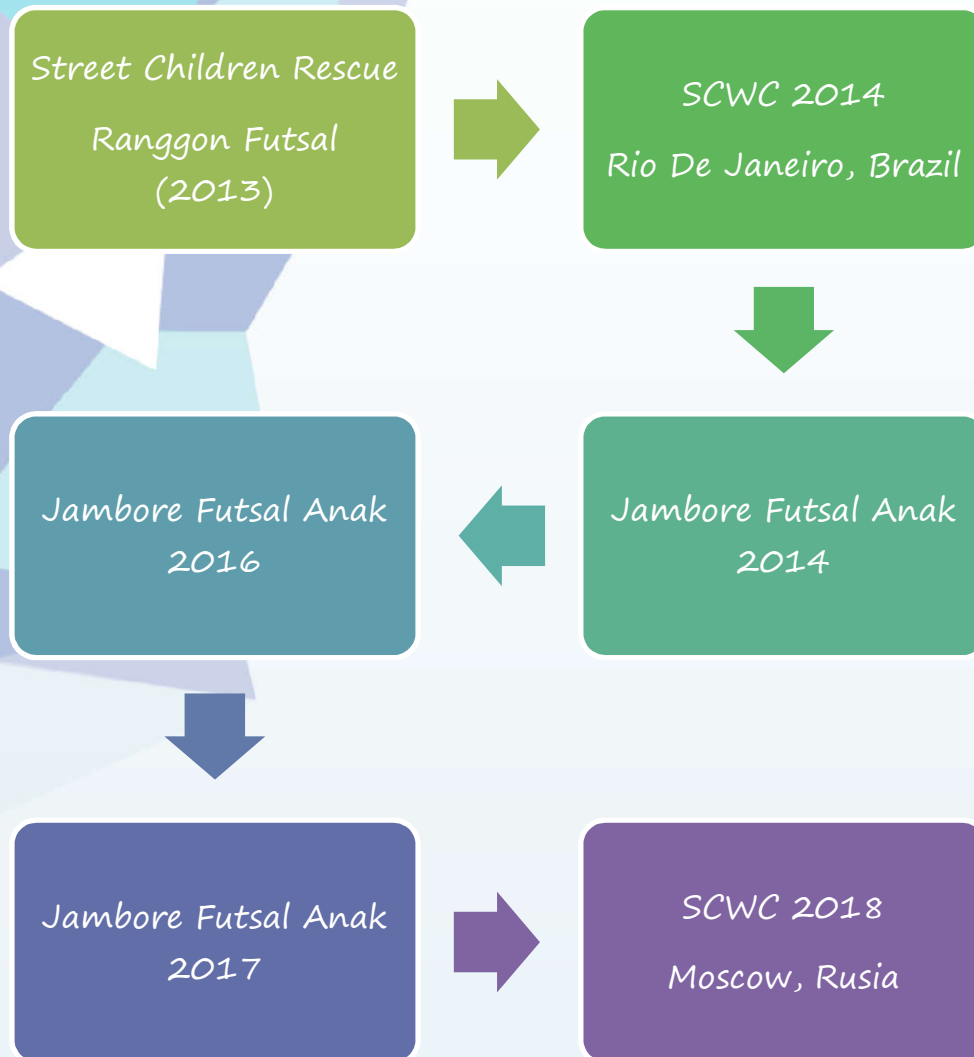
# Background and Story

We start using the sports as a tools in 2013 by conduct Futsal training activity at KDM center and few spots in Jakarta. These programs are going well, then we had an amazing opportunity to participate in Street Child Wprld Cup (SCWC) 2014 in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. We represent team Indonesia and had an amazing experience.

It strengthening our vision, to see that sports could be a very useful method for a social and behaviour change for these children. After SCWC, we were back to Indonesia with a committment to develop the program and formed a consortium named GARUDA BARU.

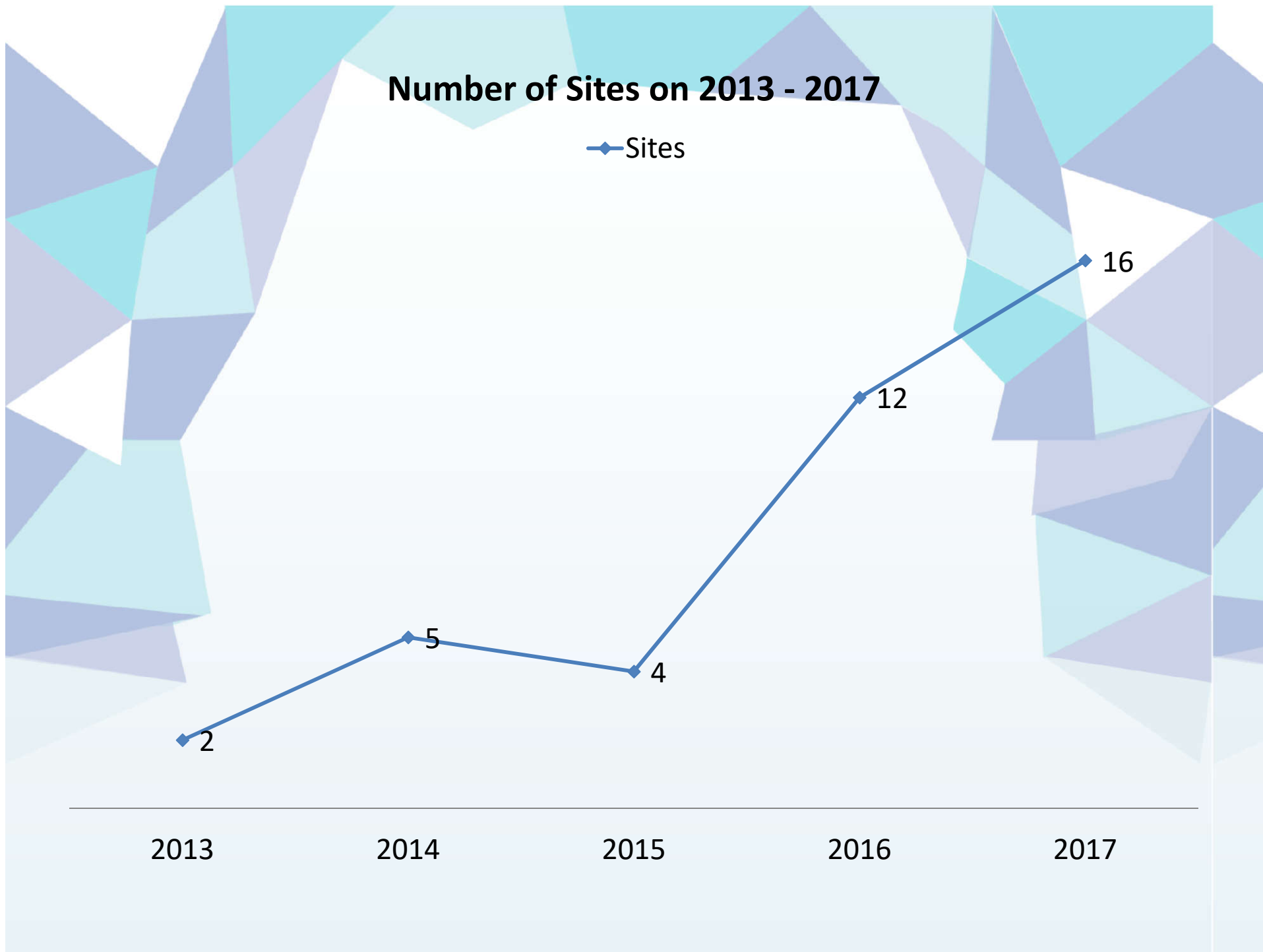

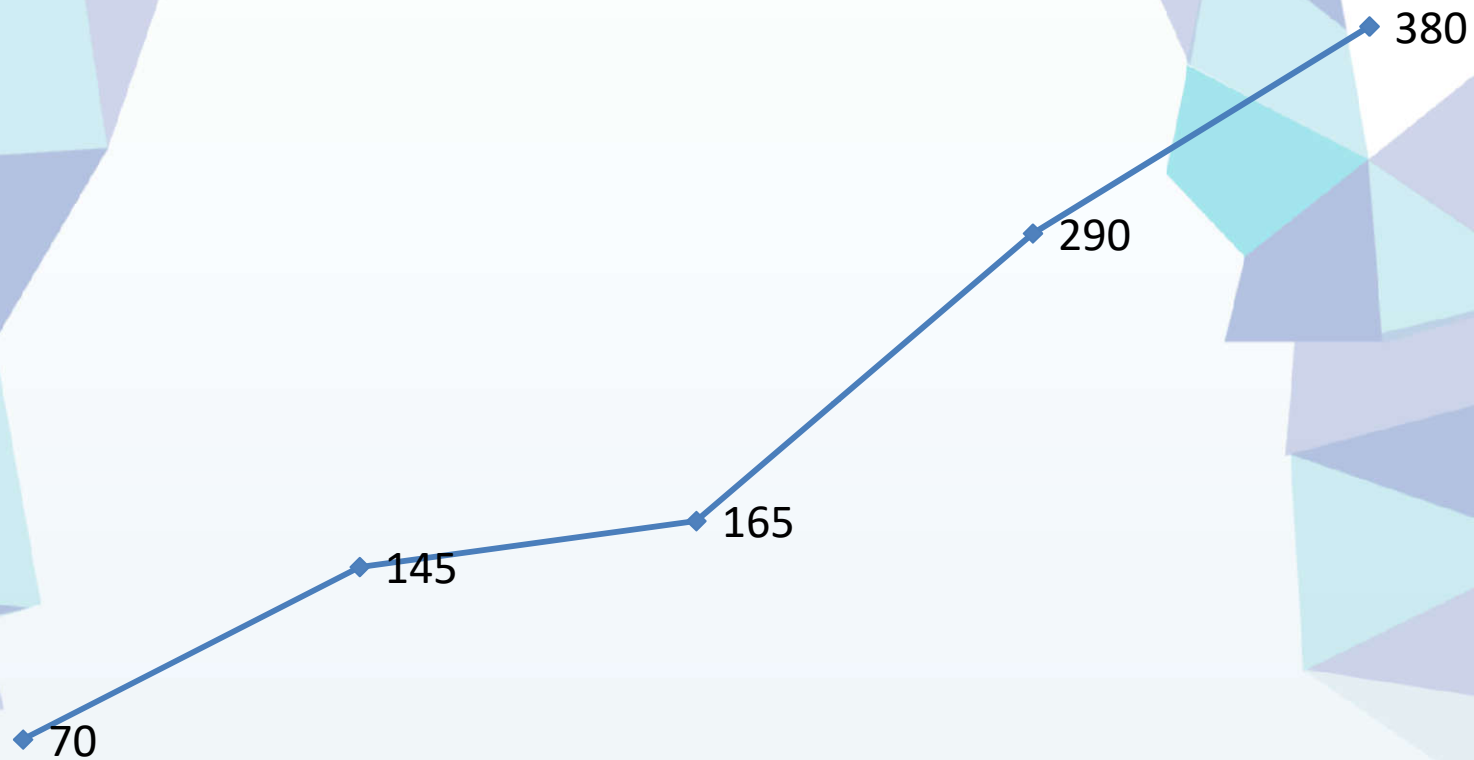

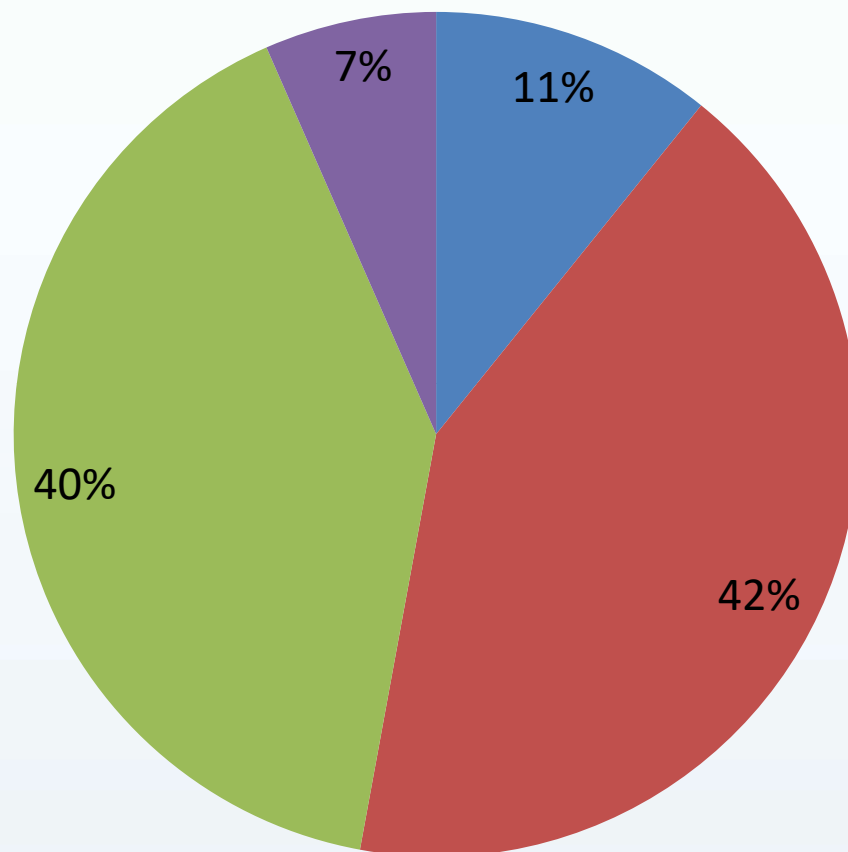
## Number of Male and Female Participant 2013 - 2017

## Number of Children by Age on 2017

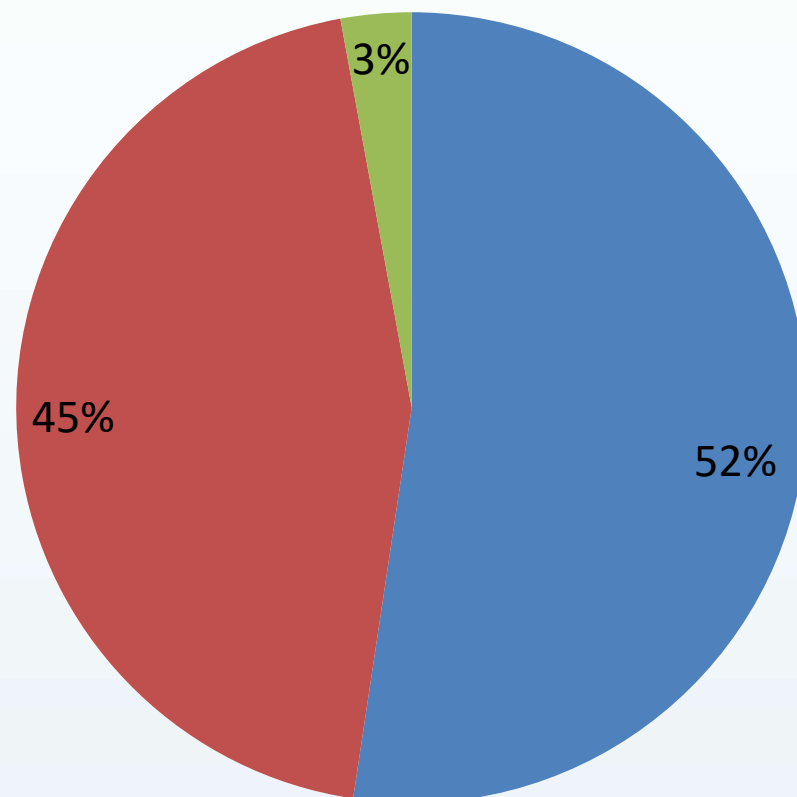

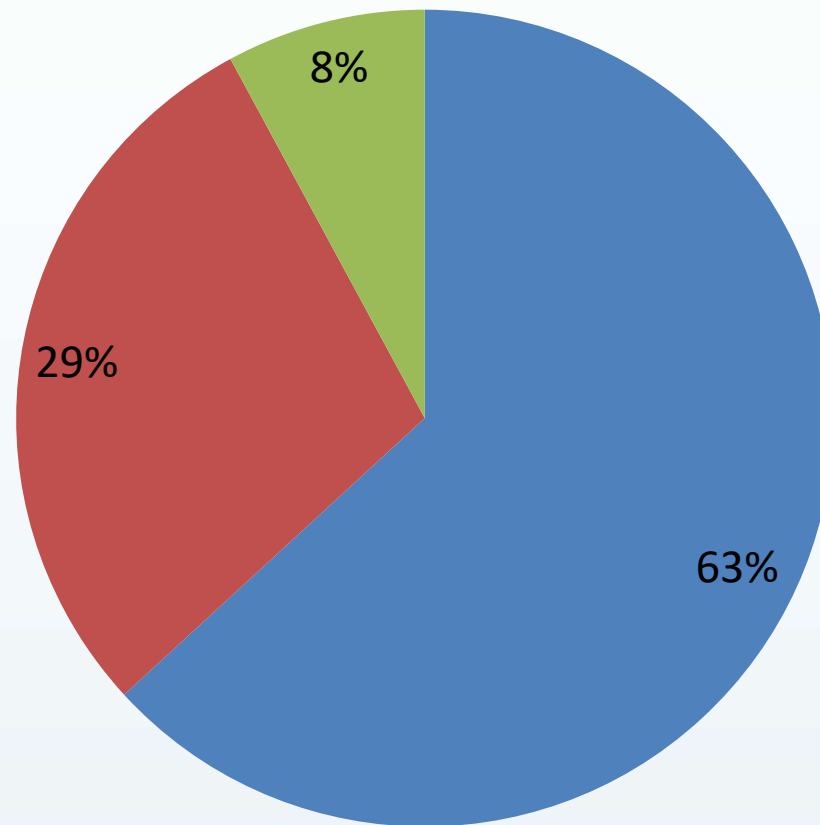
## Number of Participant by Educational Background on 2017

■ Formal ■ Non formal ■ DO

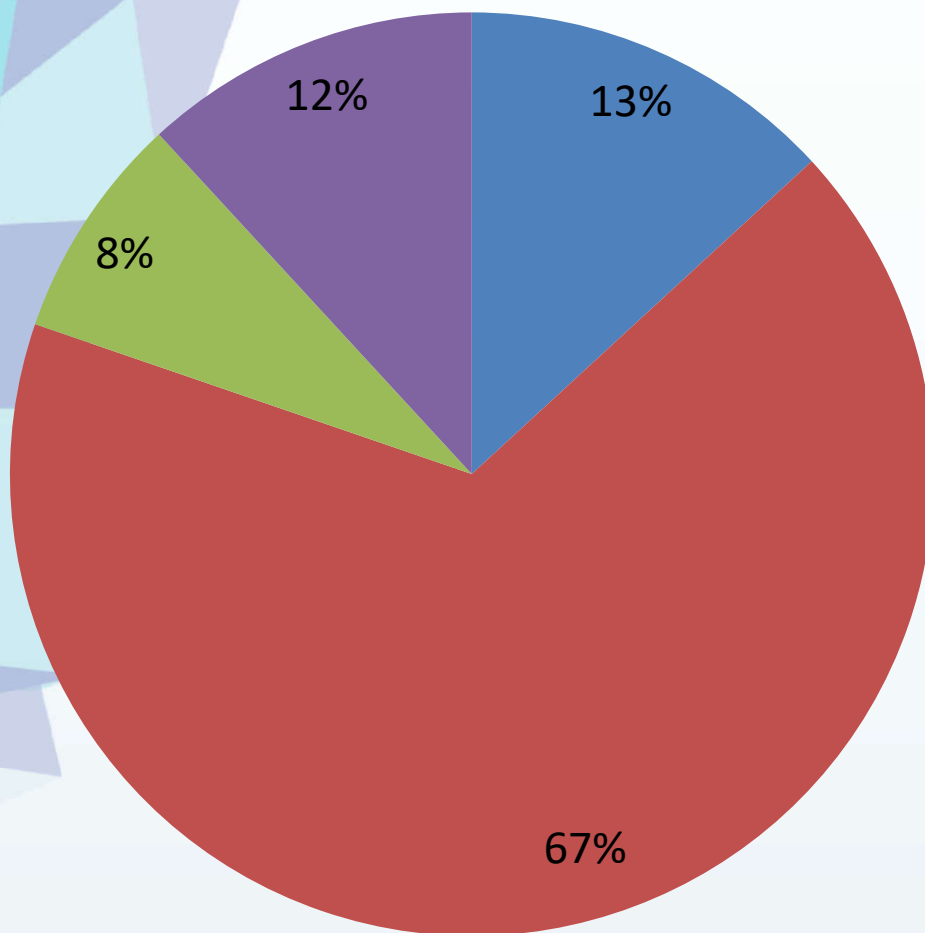


# Number of Participant by Birth Certificate Ownership on 2017

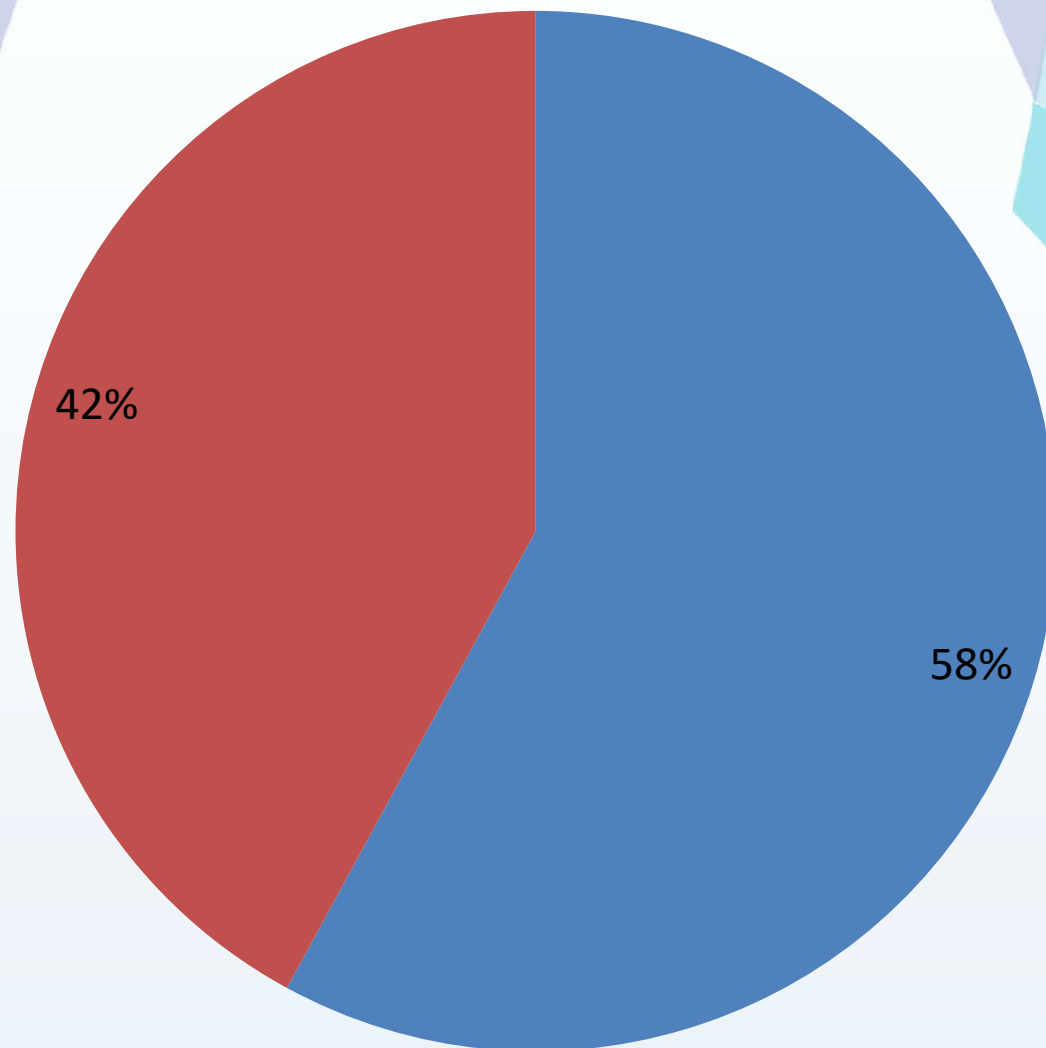
## Number of Children by Street Life Background on 2017

- Still Active on the street

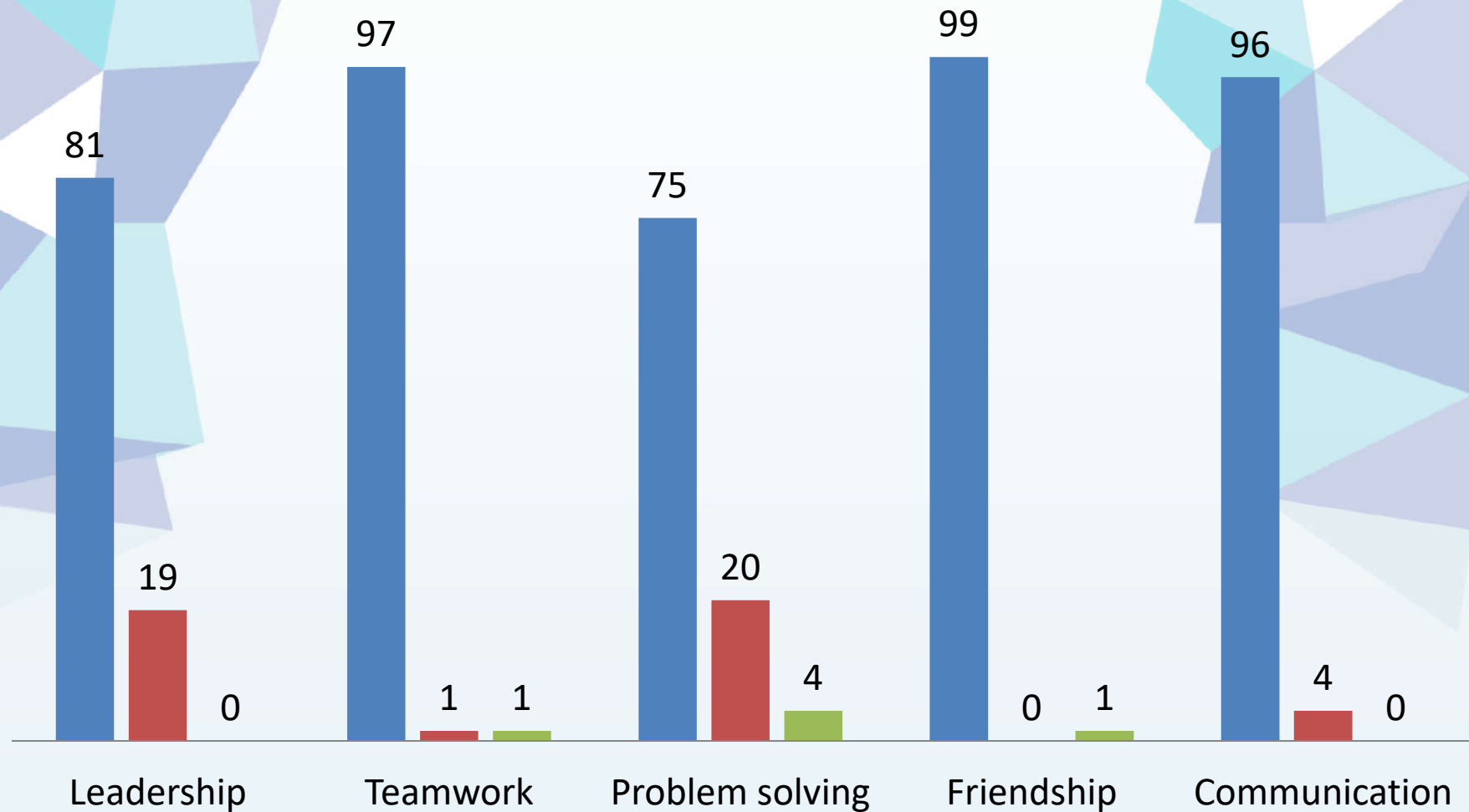
## Attendance Average during 2016
