(-9m-2015) by the Ministry of Social Affairs and Labor as a civil society organization that is directed towards social, economic and educational construction, that supports the principle of coexistence and patriotism. YWT is recently located in the Capital Secretariat, Yemen and is seeking for an expansion in a number of Yemeni provinces for the upcoming periods.

The Most Prominent Past Programs

Food Security and livelihood Program



Nutritional aid is needed in Yemen to save the lives of 3 out of every 10 inhabitant and food security support is needed for 6 out of every 10 inhabitant. Whereas food insecurity is in a continuous rise because of the instability in the availability of basic food commodities, lack of fuel, reduction in having revenue or work, market and trade disruption.

In addition, that the wheat price got raised up to 47% and the fuels price got raised up to more than 250% of what it used to be before the crisis, which resulted in the raise of commercial food distribution costs, which in turn contributes to food shortages and high prices. Raising the prices and the discontinuous availability of food means keeping it out of reach for many people, whether because of its unavailability in the markets or inability to afford.



Program Objectives

- Helping food aid reaching to 3,000 families (18,000 people).
- Improve the livelihood of 250 families (1,500).

The First Relief Campaign

The first relief campaign came in correspondence with the dreadful living conditions that Sana'a and Aden were going through during the period of 2015. Due to that, our team distributed nutrition bags to different directorates all around the two provinces, targeting the families that were stricken and majorly damaged by the ongoing war.



Food distribution project

Achieving the strategic goals of the organization the food security and livelihoods program team had distributed food baskets in June 2016 for 300 families of affected and poor families. whereas, 240 baskets were distributed in Amanat Al Asmah in partnership with Kaheer Omah initiative, as well as the distribution of 60 food baskets in Ibb governance in August in a partnership with the initiative of Mankom Waeliham.



Protection Program

According to the UN estimation, every 14.1 million person needs safety in Yemen, including emigrants, refugees, migrants and people affected by conflict. The conflict in Yemen created an enormous need of protection and safety, where the civilians face an increased death risk, injury, emigration and psychological shocks

In order, more people need basic protection and safety services, including psychological and social aid and protection from mines and UFOs in addition to financial or material help for the survivors from violation.

Program Objectives

- Providing information about psychological aid and providing a direct psychological aid treating the affected society members from the effects of war and internal conflicts.
- Awareness for children, parents and society members of the affected areas from conflicts and those with the high priority on how to protect themselves from physical injury or death due to air strikes, and the internal armed conflict, mines, unexploded ordnance and explosive remnants of war. In addition to the awareness of children recruitment seriousness.

Together in Protecting Ourselves project

The media department of the organization has prepared some motion graphic videos to explain the prevention procedures before and during air-strikes in Mars 2015. As well as posting and publishing the videos through social media and printing posters that were distributed in different public areas.



Psychological aid project (Esnad) The First Stage



Project Esnad for Psychological aid rises to manly fulfill society's needs, especially women and children's needs of the psychological aid and enabling women to psychologically support their children under the tragedies Yemen is facing today in result of the outrageous civil and external wars, that caused a deterioration and a perturbation of children physical, psychological and social conditions, not to mention how hideously forced were they to leave their homes and be displaced in temporary refugee's shelters.

The project in its first stage has already targeted 500 refugees of mostly mothers and children that were displaced from the Capital Secretariat, Sa'adah and its surroundings, through performing different specialized activities that aim to provide the refugees with the required Psychological aid.

The project has first started in July 2015, through giving a two-stages training to 30 persons of the youth on how to provide the psychological aid. After that, the team went through three field visits to various refugees' shelters, where different psychological aid activities were offered to the mothers and children.



SAFE program (Hemaya)

In accordance with the bad security situations that the Capital Secretariat have went through in 2015, especially through the first stage of the air-strikes, YWT has contributed in executing program Hemaya in corporation with a number of civil society organizations, that aims to spread the awareness of security evacuations and first aid for 2000 civilians of the Capital Secretariat. Where the organization helped in executing the four first stages of the program.



Peace Building and Governance Program



After issuance of the Global Peace Index 2016, and comparing it with the previous years it was realized that Yemen is the most affected in the world, and has the highest descending rate in many positions.

These indicators shows the importance of focusing on projects and programs that promote the values of peace and coexistence in Yemeni society, in addition to the importance of integrating youths in volunteer work.

Program Objectives

- Increasing youth and women participation in promoting the culture of peace, coexistence and citizenship.
- Introducing peace and coexistence culture through various media to the Yemeni society.
- Encouraging and promoting youth, women and civil society organizations to participate in the prioritization of Yemeni society and its harmonization with the global sustainable development objectives (Global Goals).
- Encouraging youth participation in volunteer work and refining their skills and experience through it.

Revival project (Ehyaa)

Project Ehyaa arises with the idea of enlightening the society with the culture of charity and tenderness through reviving some beautiful habits of the Yemeni society. Its first stage was Sahn Aman (A Plate of Safety) which aimed to revive the habit of exchanging food dishes between neighbors among more than 500 families all around the different directorates of the Capital Secretariat by involving the families directly with the project activities.



The project initiation in July 5th, 2015, was primarily a mass event followed by field visits to various institutions and commercial centers, and supported by publishing a video that holds the project's name and an explanation of its idea through social media.



The Training Programs

The organization aims to upgrade the organization's staff and associate volunteers' efficiency through different training programs given to them by the organization's training team in a periodical manner with the participation of some specialized trainers.

The program involves many training sessions in the institutional construction and managerial skills that are capable of introducing the trainees to the nature of institutional field of work in order to rehabilitate and upgrade their managerial skills. Moreover, in the previous period the organization has accomplished two training sessions in August and December 2015, involving many topics such as organizational structures, job descriptions, public relationships, project planning etc.



Education Program

Program Objectives

- Spreading and promoting the culture of reading for 4000 of the Yemeni youths.
- Early reading support for 2500 child in Yemen.
- Increase school enrollment for 2500 child in Yemen.
- Assisting, helping and guiding a 1000 boy and girl from the youths in future planning and choosing their university major.

According to the UN estimation, that 1.8 million child doesn't go to schools since the rise of conflicts on the 27th of May 2015, reaching with this the total population in the educational age that are not enrolled in schools to 3.4 million. Also, more than 1,100 schools were directly affected by the conflict, which exposes the education of more than 720,000 students to risk.

Educational opportunities can reduce from the conflict psychological impact on the children and the society has a paramount need for safe and equipped schools and child friendly spaces. The reintegration of vulnerable children not enrolled in school in the system is also necessary, through the educational program, and that school programs should also address the culture of violence and encourage peaceful conflict management.

Comma project (Fasela)

Fasela is a program that goals to elevate the cultural level of the society though a variety of projects. The organization has inaugurated the program in November 2015 through a mass event in the presence of well-educated figures. The event also involved a various sections some of which were explaining the projects idea and displaying videos that embody the project's goals and stages. Furthermore, the event involved presenting successful examples of today's readers and educated youth.
