Eyes On Refugees Story:

Throughout 2015 and 2016 Jennifer Silverstone, RN volunteered in several refugee camps across Europe where she provided medical help and comfort to refugees.

Born out of these trips was Eyes on Refugees, which officially became a 501(c)(3), non-profit organization in April 2016.

In October 2016, Jennifer and her family hosted a family from Syria, homeless. What started out as a two week stay, turned into three rewarding months for Jennifer, her family and the family they hosted.

It was during this hosting experience that Jennifer found a way to help bridge a gap that occurs around three months after their arrival in the U.S. It is at this point that resources and mentors are no longer available to assist refugees in navigating the steps that bring them to independence.

"It takes a tribe of volunteers to mentor and support these families, so that they can begin to rebuild their lives in a foreign culture, and come to a place in which they are interwoven into the fabric of our communities.
