

Project for **GlobalGiving** to Support – **MOSHWANI OUTPATIENT CLINIC:**

The Moshwani Outpatient Clinic, located 35 miles north of Kabul, is the only clinic (after 2 closed) in the Kalakan district that provides free medical and dental services to 9 villages with approximately 14,000 people. The clinic began in 2005. The services offered are: general medical care, birth control, family care, prenatal care, vaccination, and dental care. There 11 clinic staff including a doctor, dentist, midwife, certified vaccinator, pharmacist, and technicians.



The **annual operating cost** of the clinic is as follows:

Medical Staff	\$30,000 (personally delivered by a OAAW official)
Medical Supplies	\$ 7,000 (cheaply purchased in Iran/Pakistan)
Reserve for emergencies	\$ 1,500 (medical specialist, ambulance need)
Communication, deliveries, etc.	\$ 1,500 (postage, courier, deliveries, phone/internet)



Goal: Long-term goal is for the clinic to increase its daily patients to 200/day (now it is at 80) by expanding its reach to more children for preventive care, provide training workshops on midwifery to reduce birth mortality, and conduct regular lectures in health and dietary habits.

Partner Organization: The Organization for the Advancement of Afghan Women (OAAW) is the coordinating agency, a non-profit 501(c)3 organization based in NY.

Source of Funds: Annual Fundraising by the Global ShareResource Foundation and OAAW.
