ednica against street child labor have achieved

- 1. 70 scholarships for boys and girls to continue in school.
- 2. 103 children who work at street received direct assistance at their workplace.
- 3. 118 children go to our day centers to:
 - 🖌 eat
 - ✓ bathe and learn hygiene habits
 - use the library and the computer center
 - 🗸 play
 - ✓ receive psychological and legal support
 - ✓ learn and exercise their human rights
 - ✓ and participate in other free activities!!

We want to encourage children to leave work in the street and instead work towards earning their high school diploma.

ednica

helping young people who live on the street have achieved

- 1. 22 families, especially those headed by single mothers or without support, receive a scholarship to rent their own space.
- 2. 10 girls and boys have been temporarily referred to foundations with residential places.
- 3. 67 tenagers and young adults go to our day centers to:
 - ✓ bathe
 - 🗸 eat
 - wash clothes
 - 🗸 play
 - ✓ receive psychological and legal support
 - ✓ reduce their drug use
 - ✓ access employment opportunities
 - ✓ and participate in other free activities!!

ednica personnel visit the children on the streets to monitor their wellbeing and protect them from violence and police harassment.
