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SIGHT is one of the five senses we are born with,-God's gift to us, which many of us take for granted. But look around, not all are blessed with these senses. Some people are born with or develop impaired vision, hearing or speech. Some have partial loss of vision and others more unfortunate have total loss of vision. These people have as much right to live fruitful lives as those without disability. It is not easy for the visually impaired, but some people with such disabilities do persevere in life through determination, hard work and self confidence. One such person is Shri Shivaprakash of Mysore. He is completely blind yet remarkably he completed an M.A. in Political Science.What sets him apart from others is his concern for people with similar disabilities and a desire to help them succeed in life. Being blind has not stopped him succeeding academically or vocationally because he has a clear vision about his goals and the means to achieve them. And thus was born DIVYA JYOTHI CHARITABLE TRUST in 2008, a non-profit, non-Governmental Organization, with Shri Shivaprakash as the Managing Trustee and three other trustees

we have trained more than 120 blind students by providing them computer education and we have also provided text books in Braille script for 4800 students across Karnataka. Blind children are usually separated from rest of the children but here we mold them not to depend on anyone and to stand on their feet and get a good job with proper computer education. Many of the students come from many parts of Karnataka state and to accommodate them and to give food we are in need of a hostel in which can accommodate at least 180 students. Currently we are running training center, and hostel in two separate rented premises, which are separated by 16 km. The training center also houses our Braille transcription and printing center and Braille library. We are providing food, education and books to students with the help of donors. We want to enhance our capacity and train many more students and help them to lead a better life.

The goal of the Trust is to provide holistic, dedicated support to the physically and visually impaired people of Mysore to enable them to live productive, happy and independent lives. To make them realize their potential - not as "disabled", but as "differently abled". To achieve the above goal the Trust has already taken up several activities which are detailed below:

Currently we are providing these facilities to students.

- "Computer education" to the visually challenged persons. This helps them not only in their day to day life, they can get employment also as computer literacy is a must in every industry now a days.
- English learning program (English communication skills & grammar) to enhance linguistic skills of the blind who are also mostly socially and economically backward.
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- Training on career building, pre-vocational and job placement assistance for blind unemployed people, especially for women; Vocational training for blind women to help them pursue a career as a call center operator, reception, etc.

Some of the key achievements of the Organisation are :

- The trust has been running computer classes for the visually impaired since 2011 and so far have trained 120 blind people in basic computer skills.
- Spoken English classes were held for all the above visually challenged persons to help them improve their communication skill in English.
- Library with Braille books are being provided.
- Printing and distribution of Braille books is undertaken.
- Books covering various areas of interest in Braille are published.
- Braille teaching classes are conducted.
- Pick and drop service free of charge to visually impaired is being offered.
- Hostel Accommodation to 22 visually impaired persons is being provided.
- Organizing sports, cultural events, Yoga classes for blinds, placement services, financing the economically disadvantaged blind youths etc., are undertaken.
